

# Real Estate Purchase 200 Strawberry Hill Avenue



# **Board Request**

- Planning Board
  - Resolution authorizing the purchase of the property and improvements thereon, commonly known as 200 Strawberry Hill Avenue, from the Sisters of St. Joseph
  - Capital Appropriation for the land acquisition [not to exceed \$10 million]
  - Capital Appropriation for construction [not to exceed \$55 million]
- Board of Finance/Board of Representatives —the above, plus
  - Resolution amending the capital budget for Fiscal Year 2014-15 by Adding an Appropriation of up to [\$10 million] for the acquisition
  - Resolution amending the capital budget for Fiscal Year 2014-15 by Adding an Appropriation of up to [\$55 million] for the renovations

# 200 Strawberry Hill Avenue

Concurrent with the purchase of the property, we are filing school construction grant applications in the event the City determines the best use of the property is as a school

- Applying for both inter- and intra-district school funding
  - Inter 80% state funding/20% city funding (approximately)
  - Intra 28% state funding/72% city funding (approximately)
- As part of the grant application, the City is required to demonstrate that it has in place the authorization to acquire the funds to build the school
  - This authorization must be in place by June 30, 2014
  - Will require Special Meeting of the BOR

# 200 Strawberry Hill Avenue

- Centrally located, easily accessible
- 10.8 acres of land
- Tax exempt parcel
- Existing school (21 classrooms + gym and cafeteria buildings, historical barn)
- Constructed in 1928/1975
- 2007-2013 leased by Stanwich School vacating July, 2014
- Barn and Cottage are a National Historic Site (former Stamford Theater Works)
- Zoned R 7.5 (7,500 sq ft single family lot)
- Potential for 46 single family lots under current zoning
- Master plan allowance for up to ~180 units





# Use of Property

- This acquisition is perhaps a once-in-a-generation opportunity
  to preserve Stamford character & history and to acquire a large,
  beautifully-situated, centrally-located piece of land
- Could help address elementary school overcrowding
- From the 2002 Stamford Master Plan (pp. 43-44)
  - "In resident surveys, lack of recreational activity was the #2 response to the question, what do you like least about living in Stamford? ... Another priority should be placed on additional playgrounds and ball fields in the central portion of the city, so as to relieve pressure on Scalzi Park perhaps the city's most used park. 'Out of the box' ideas will need to be surfaced in order to deal with the simple fact that the most heavily-used recreational facilities will be in the center of Stamford, where there is greater convenience to the greatest number of people."
