RE: Mold Growth Impacted Non-Asbestos-Containing Drywall Removal

Work will commence at Northeast Elementary School on Monday, May 6, 2019, for the removal of mold growth impacted non-asbestos containing drywall in the Media Center Toilet Room. Removal work is anticipated to take one night and will be conducted from 4:00 PM to 12:30 AM..

Please be advised work will be conducted in accordance with United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) guidelines for Mold Remediation in Schools and Commercial Buildings. The work will also be conducted in accordance with work procedures developed by Tighe & Bond, Inc., the City of Stamford's third-party Environmental Consultant/Industrial Hygienist.

The work is being conducted by A.A.I.S., Inc., an environmental remediation company. Tighe & Bond representatives will be onsite during the work to observe and document work conducted by A.A.I.S. Following work, restoration work (replacement of drywall) may not be conducted immediately to allow for the monitoring of water intrusion and leaks.

Please note this work is one part of a larger, comprehensive project at Northeast focusing on identifying water intrusion and mold growth issues within the building and permanently correcting any identified deficiencies. The City of Stamford Mold Task Force is working with an Architect/Engineer, Environmental Consultant, Construction Manager, General Contractor, and Remediation Contractor to identify and correct areas of concern at Northeast.
