#2022-09 - 110 Pond Road-Parcel "B", Lot 110 - D'Andrea Surveying & Engineering for G&T Pond, LLC: The applicant is proposing construction of a new single family dwelling with driveway, drainage, and landscaping proximate to watercourses and conservation easements on an undeveloped property. Additionally, the project will include the construction of an access way and a proposed stream channel to facilitate flow of the existing drainage swale. The subject property lies within the non-public drinking water supply watershed of the Rippowam River. The property is situated along the south side of Pond Road, approximately 340 feet west of the intersection of Pond Road and Blueberry Drive, and approximately 1,400 feet west of the intersection of Pond Road and Stillwater Road, and is identified as Parcel "B", List 004-4305, Card W-006A, Block 360, Map 102, Zone R-20, and ±0.7289 Acres.

#2022-10 - 2517 Long Ridge Road-Lot A - Infinity Group DBA for Kingdom Full Tabernacle International Ministries: To redevelop the existing tennis club into a religious institution with associated amenities proximate to wetlands and watercourses on a property situated within the drinking water supply watershed of the Mianus River (East Branch). The property is situated along the west side of Long Ridge Road, approximately 500 feet north of the intersection of Graybirch and Long Ridge Roads, and is identified as Lot A, Account 001-3577, Card W 147, Map 23, Block 399, Zone RA-2, and is ±14.93 Acres.

#2022-04 - 1349 Newfield Avenue-Lot A - Sterling Farms Golf Course - City of Stamford (Extension): To conduct hydro-raking activities within and proximate to wetlands and two ponds on property situated within the non-drinking water supply watersheds of the Springdale Brook, Ayers Brook, and Noroton River. The property is situated along the east side of Newfield Avenue, approximately 50 east of the intersection of Newfield Avenue and Newfield Drive, and is identified as Lot A, Account 002-6063, Card E 073, Map 78, Block 380, Zone P, and is ± 132.500 Acres.
