As discussed, we are submitting updated materials and information to address comments from staff, referral boards, and other City departments, including: Land Use Bureau staff; HPAC Resolution comments from our March 1, 2022 meeting date; Engineering Bureau comments dated March 25, 2022; WPCA comments dated March 28, 2022; TTP comments dated March 31, 2022; and feedback from our community outreach.

A summary of updates can be found below.

- 1) **Updated façade design and materials**. In response to both HPAC and Planning Board comments regarding EIFS, we undertook a study of alternative façade material. We examined the durability, sustainability and aesthetics of each material in making selections. Material changes include:
 - Replaced the Dryvit Terraneo Block with a Hardie system at the first story along Lafayette Street.
 - b. Changed the "bumped out" bays in the 2nd-4th stories to Hardie.
 - c. Changed the "inset" bays in the 2nd-4th stories to light Hardie Panel system.
 - d. The 5-story portion along E. Main and the Lafayette corner will be a Hardie system with a Dryvit Terraneo block system only at the retail level.
 - This type of material has been well received in its use at The Stillwater.
 - e. The lower level of the 4-story portion will be concrete with formwork pattern. Wellbuilt spent time in SoNo looking at different patterns and how they were successfully implemented in the design of buildings near the Sound.
 - f. Added a "green wall" system to the lower level of the 4-story portion to break up the concrete formwork, adding an additional green component to the project.
- 2) **The Landscape Plan** has been updated to respond to TTP comments. The new plans also incorporate the new green wall feature along Lafayette Street.



- 3) **Flood mitigation** has been enhanced from the already robust strategies and designs adopted by the project. The architectural plans (and the site plan will be updated to coordinate) show an increased elevation for the vehicular entrance to the parking area within the site, to further protected against any elevated water levels. The substitution of a concrete formwork for the façade along Lafayette and North State Street increase the durability of the building.
- 4) **Tenant relocation efforts** are ongoing. Our team is working with our tenants as well as the owner of 15 Lafayette to find the ideal relocation solution for each individual. An overview of some of the efforts is attached. Some highlights include:
 - a. The hiring of a private broker (Newbridge Realty) to further assist tenants in the relocation process.
 - b. WellBuilt has already been coordinating with tenants of properties they control within the previously approved project area. Of the 5 residential tenants, 3 have already found alternative housing, and others have been in contact with the provided real estate broker.
 - c. Regular communication between 15 Lafayette tenants and their building management, including providing additional relocation assistance resources (e.g. Charter Oak Communities, United Way of CT, etc.)
- 5) **Departmental Comments.** We can accept all comments from Engineering, WPCA, and TTP (3/31/22 memo) as conditions of approval to be fully addressed prior to receipt of a Building Permit.

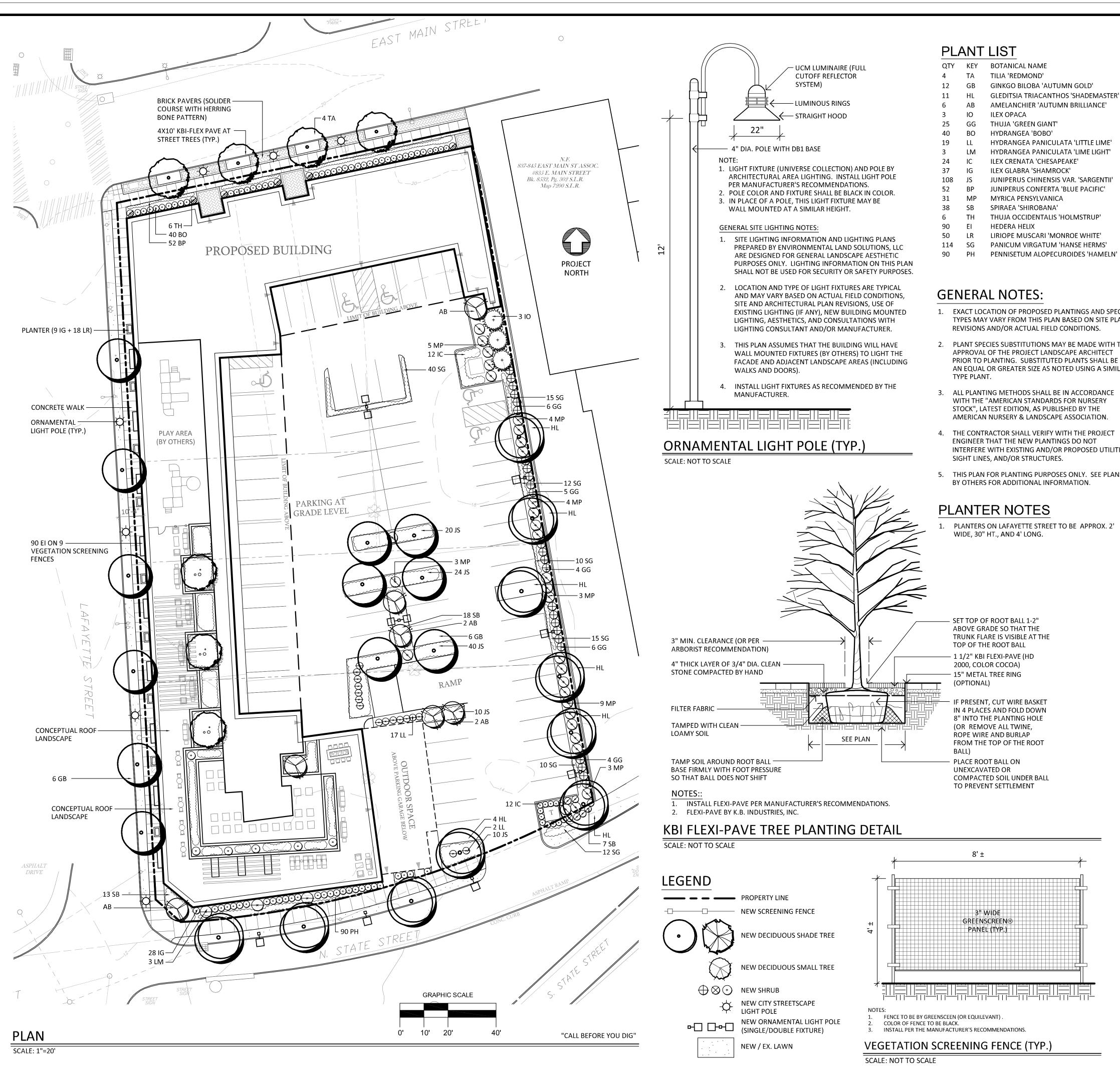
We hope you find these changes, as we do, to be an enhancement of an already attractive redevelopment of a Stamford neighborhood in need of revitalization.

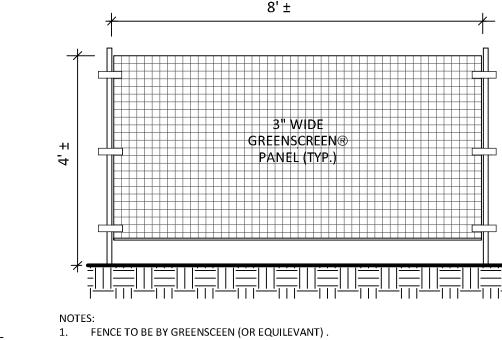

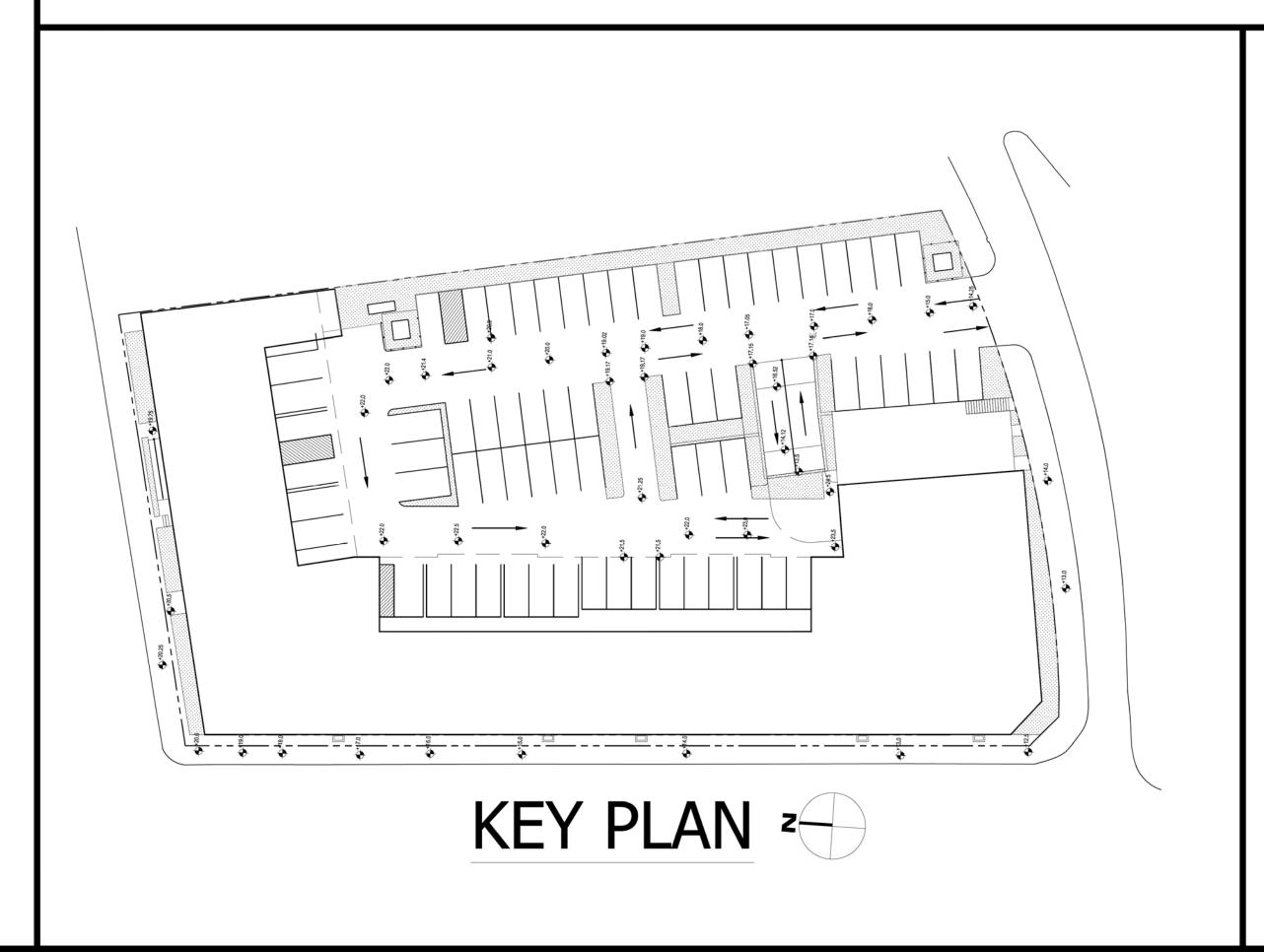
