Park Attendant Report Cove, West, Cummings and Scalzi Parks

The Memorial Day weekend 05/27/22 - 05/30/22.

We have summarized below some of the rules we advised patrons on, most are same issues and patrons were not aware of them and some patrons thinking of them as insignificant. There were no major incidents.

- 1:40 pm 05/28 Cove- Someone called 911 to report someone crashed on the rocks, but it was a false alarm.
- 8:23 pm 05/28 Scalzi informed a mother to watch her little boy, he was riding a bike on the drive lane.
- 2:30 pm 05/29 Cove a man was being verbally aggressive towards a kid, and we called the police.
- 3:02 pm Scalzi people using a gas propane tank grill and told them to put it away and they complied.
- 11:30 am Cummings People were setting up a grill next to the sand in the quite area. They were advised to do it on the picnic area.
- 5:25 pm 05/29 Cummings A man was intoxicated and went into the water; the lifeguard called the fire department.
- At 7:03 05/29 Scalzi found a little girl who was lost crying, we found her parents right away.
- 1.07 05/30 Scalzi dog leashed to a tree.

The below are common and repeated park rule violations but almost all the time the patrons were cooperative and complied.

- People drinking beer in glass bottles.
- People drinking after 9:00 pm
- Loud music (especially Scalzi and Cummings)
- Pop up tents. We advised them not to use it. Some questioned the safety of an umbrella versus popup tents. There are no signs posted restricting popup tents. Pete was helpful in advising us to refer popup tents issues to the lifeguards until signs are posted.



- Dogs not on a leash.
- People in restricted areas (rocks) mostly Cummings.
