Access' "Invalid Coach" provides a van that accommodates wheel chairs. Users pay \$70.00 per one way trip, plus \$7.00 per mile if the trip is out of the city. # Transportation Options

## **EASY ACCESS**

Easy Access provides door-to-door, on demand transportation to Stamford residents who are unable to use the fixed-route bus service because of their disabilities. Easy Access operates during the same hours as CT Transit buses at a current cost of \$2.60 per one-way trip. Easy Access users must be certified for the eligibility before using the service.

Riders may purchase Easy Access tickets by mail at Norwalk Transit District 275 Wilson Avenue Norwalk, CT 06854 or in person at the Stamford Government Center cashiering and permitting.

## **STAMFORD SENIOR TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (SST)**

SST provides door-to-door transportation to non-disabled Stamford seniors to and from Senior Nutrition program sites and any location in Stamford daily, as well as to and from local shopping centers on a weekly basis.

The current cost of SST is \$2.60 per one-way trip. SST reservations should be made at least three days in advance of travel by at least three days in advance of travel by calling Norwalk Transit.

## **SHARE THE FARE TAXI PROGRAM**

All Stamford senior citizens and individuals with documented disabilities are eligible for half-price taxi rides through Stamford's Share the Fare program. Before using this program you must first purchase taxi vouchers. Vouchers are sold in books of 10. The cost per book is \$25.00; the value of each book of vouchers is \$50.00. Vouchers must be purchased in person at the cashiering and permitting window, off the first floor lobby, Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m and 8:00 am to 4:00 pm during the summer. The maximum monthly purchase is \$100.00 or four books. All three Stamford taxi companies participate in Share the Fare. For ease of scheduling, their telephone numbers are on the face of each voucher.

## **CONNECTICUT TRANSIT BUS SERVICE**

Bus service runs weekdays from 5:30 am to 10:30 p.m.; Saturdays from 5:50 a.m. to 9:00p.m. and Sundays from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.; If you purchase tokens in advance of rides you may take advantage of the 65¢ senior discount fare.
