1. Call to Order and Roll Call

S. Barocas called the meeting to order at 5:02 pm. A quorum was not present.

2. Approval of the June 20, 2022 and May 16, 2022 Finance Committee Meeting Minutes

The June 20 and the May 16, 2022 meeting minutes were approved.

4. June 2022 financial update & update on receivables/arrears (M. Turndahl)

M. Turndahl provided the June 2022 accounts receivable balance update: Sewer use receivable balance was \$3.39 million up from the June 2021 balance of \$2.94 million, over \$19 thousand was applied to the oldest receivables and the average collection rate through June 2022 was 99.02% up from 98.85% reported for May 2022. Sewer use and sewer connection and assessment cash collections through June 2022 was behind the previous June by \$1.37 million. He then provided details to the June 2022 Income Statement reporting net income of \$2.69 million, ahead of budget by \$2.1 million, a pooled cash balance of \$8.17 million and a reserve account of \$22.12 million.

D. Yanik questioned the Miscellaneous Income overage of \$516 thousand. M. Turndahl responded that the budget overage is mainly the result of a one-time energy savings credit of \$470 thousand.
