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BOARD OF FINANCE RESOLUTION CONCERNING TAX RATES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

May 25, 2022

WHEREAS, Section 8-30-10 of the *City of Stamford Charter* states that on or before the twenty-fifth day of May, the Board of Finance shall determine and fix the tax rates and service charges upon the ratable estate in each of the tax districts of the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-40-10 of the *City of Stamford Charter* states that all motor vehicles within the City shall be taxed at a uniform city-wide mill rate; and

WHEREAS, Section 180-2 of the *City of Stamford Charter* states that the mill rate for personal property in the Personal Property Tax District shall be equal to the mill rate for real property in the "A" tax district;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Charter Sec. C8-30-10 and General Statutes Sec. 7-361 the Board of Finance approved an additional tax levy to provide for a \$20,000,000 Reserve for Capital Non-Recurring Expenses for the benefit of the Long Term Facilities plan of the Board of Education and included this additional tax levy in its approved mill rates;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to General Statutes Sec. 7-361, the \$20,000,000 additional tax levy required approval from the Board of Representatives;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to General Statutes Sec. 7-361, the Board of Representatives approved Resolution 4139 approving the additional mill rates necessary to collect the \$20,000,000 additional tax levy at a Special Meeting held on May 23, 2022;

WHEREAS, This resolution of the Board of Finance and Resolution 4139 of the Board of Representatives are intended to be read and implemented together.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF STAMFORD BOARD OF FINANCE that the tax rates set forth herein were read into the official record at a Special Board of Finance meeting held on May 17, 2022:

<i>Tax District "B":</i>	26:68	mills
<i>Tax District "C":</i>	26.33	mills
<i>Tax District "C/S":</i>	26.74	mills
<i>Personal Property District:</i>	27.17	mills
<i>Motor Vehicles:</i>	27.25	mills
