This Citation and Notification of Penalty (this Citation) describes violations of the Connecticut Occupational Safety and Health Act. The running of this contest period is not interrupted by an informal conference.

If you decide to request an informal conference, please complete, remove and post the page 4 Notice to Employees next to this Citation and Notification of Penalty as soon as the time, date, and place of the informal conference have been determined. Be sure to bring to the conference any and all supporting documentation of existing conditions as well as any abatement steps taken thus far. If conditions warrant, we can enter into an informal settlement agreement which amicably resolves this matter without litigation or contest.

Right to Contest – You have the right to contest this Citation and Notification of Penalty. You may contest all citation items or only individual items. You may also contest proposed penalties and/or abatement dates without contesting the underlying violations. <u>Unless you inform the CONN-OSHA Director in writing that you intend to contest the citation(s) and /or proposed penalty(ies) within 15 working days after receipt, the citation(s) and the proposed penalty(ies) will become a final order of the Connecticut Occupational Health and Safety Review Commission and may not be reviewed by any court or agency.</u>

Penalty Payment – Penalties are due within 15 working days of receipt of this notification unless contested. (See the enclosed booklet.) Make your check or money order payable to "CTDOL CONN-OSHA". Please indicate the Inspection Number on the remittance.

Notification of Corrective Action – For violations which you do not contest, you should notify CONN-OSHA promptly by letter that you have taken appropriate corrective action within the time frame set forth on this Citation. Please inform the CONN-OSHA office in writing of the abatement steps you have taken and of their dates, together with adequate supporting documentation, e.g., drawings or photographs of corrected conditions, purchase/work orders related to abatement actions, air sampling results, etc.
