REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION: SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL PROJECT APPROPRIATION REQUESTS:

Mr. Romano gave details about the necessity for the Closeout and the shift of the \$100,000.00 from the Fire Training Center account to the Fire Apparatus account.

1. <u>CAPITAL PROJECT CLOSEOUT RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: Pursuant to Stamford City Code Section 8-2, partial closeout is recommended on the following capital projects:

After a brief discussion, Mr. Levin recommended approval of the Capital Project Closeout Recommendation for the Fire Training Center in the amount of \$100,000.00. 2. FIRE APPARATUS - PROJECT #C63005: We are requesting to reallocate \$100,000.00 from Fire Training to Fire Apparatus. This is an emergency due to the unforeseen failure of Engine #6 (engine & frame). This apparatus must be removed from service. The replacement must be purchased ASAP due to a lack of reserves.

After a brief discussion, Mr. Totilo recommended approval of the Fire Apparatus - Project #C63005 in the amount of \$100,000.00. The Board has reviewed this request pursuant to Section 8-24 of the Connecticut General Statute and Section C6-30-13 of the City Charter and finds this request to be consistent with CGS Section 8-24, and Section C6-30-13 of the City Charter, as well as consistent with the adopted 2015 Master Plan; Mr. Levin seconded the motion and passed unanimously with eligible members present voting, 3-0 (Dell, Levin and Totilo).
