Part A - Description of Request

This resolution is before the board in order to receive and allocate an additional appropriation of a utility funded rebated associated with a roof top unit (RTU) replacement project at Stark Elementary School. This project identified as CPBM14 Julia Stark – MTF will be reimbursed through a special one-time rebate program offered by Eversource. Thanks to Eversource, efforts by several BOE personnel including Cindy Grafstein, Kevin McCarthy and John Perna, and in cooperation with several personnel from city engineering, SPS applied for and was ultimately selected receive up to 50% of the estimated installed cost. In this case the incentive amounted to \$165,000 or half of the qualified installed cost of \$330,000 for the installation of six (6), 142.5 ton high efficiency units (EER 15) with demand control ventilation (DCV) to supply heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) to several areas of the building

- To be eligible for an incentive payment, all EEMs must be installed by the Participant and accepted by both the Participant and the Company by 7/15/2021. Failure of Participant to install all EEMs as described and shown in the attached Exhibits by 7/15/2021 may disqualify Participant from receiving an incentive payment.
- 4. As administrator of the Energy Efficiency Fund, the Company agrees to pay incentives for all EEMs that comply with the terms and criteria specified in the Exhibit(s). The incentive paid for each measure will not exceed the amount listed for the measure in the Exhibit(s) unless the measure description allows for such changes. The total incentive for all measures as listed in the Exhibit(s) is \$165,000.00.
