Mr. Callion asked that the proposed Marine facility be phased over three years: \$150,000, \$400,000 and \$410,000. He added that a bid for the communications system had been awarded to Motorola for approximately \$15 million.

The Police Chief stated that improvements to the jail were a priority. He said that the substation plan did not work due to a lack of staffing.

The Chief of the TOR Fire Department suggested that a comprehensive facility study of all big five stations be undertaken. Mr. Callion agreed to present such a proposal. It was also agreed that the first TOR project would be reviewed with OPM.
