Eleven people spoke in opposition citing concerns over drainage, landscaping, stability of the proposed wall, intensity of development, impact on character of the neighborhood, impact on existing trees and potential blasting. Mrs. Fishman moved to recommend approval. Mr. Tepper seconded the motion and it passed with Mr. Hill, Mrs. Grosso, Mrs. Dell, Mrs. Fishman and Mr. Tepper voting.
