Re: Water Stained Building Materials and/or Mold Growth Visual Assessment Limited 5th Floor Areas of Board of Education Stamford Government Center 888 Washington Boulevard, Stamford, Connecticut

Dear Mr. Zachery,

On December 17, 2018, Mr. Kevin McCarthy of Tighe & Bond, Inc. (Tighe & Bond) performed a visual assessment for the City of Stamford Public Schools through the Mold Task Force (the "City"). The visual assessment was conducted within limited areas on the 5th Floor of the Stamford Government Center, 888 Washington Boulevard, Stamford, Connecticut (the "Site"), and included the 5th Floor Women's Toilet Room and Cubicles C, D, G, and F.

During the visual assessment, Mr. McCarthy performed a visual and olfactory assessment of the Site and noted the following:

- No visible water staining and/or mold growth was observed in the women's toilet room, cubicle area, and/or above ceiling tiles assessed;
- No visible mold growth and/or dust was observed on the Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) vents.
- Vinyl wallcovering was observed in the women's toilet room in areas where water may impact the material.

Based on the visual assessment conducted and information available, Tighe & Bond concludes the areas assessed do not have a water stained building materials and/or mold growth concern.

Tighe & Bond recommends the vinyl wall covering be removed in the 5th floor women's toilet room, as the material is not appropriate for a toilet room. It is inappropriate due to the materials inability to dry when it becomes wet. Tighe & Bond recommends the vinyl wall covering be removed and replaced with a mold-inhibiting paint.
