2. Southeast Quadrant

(a) Re-Use Parcel 36 – Approve LDA & Conceptual Design Plans – Attorney Goldberg distributed a letter from F.D. Rich Counsel Donald Gustafson agreeing to the changes in the Land Disposition Agreement (LDA) between The F.D. Rich Company and the Urban Redevelopment Commission for Re-Use Parcel 36 (corner Main Street and Greyrock Place) submitted for Commission approval on this date (copy attached as part of these official minutes).

Chairman Osman noted that URC Design Advisor Alan Plattus made some comments/suggestions at the May 30th Sub-Committee meeting with regard to the glass façade. The architects, Studio AKB, agreed to look at the reflectiveness of the glass exterior. John L. Lindell, Director of Design & Construction for The F.D. Rich Company, reviewed the items as follows:

- Parking Garage sleek horizontal grilles for screening a sample will be provided.
- Retail as much glass as possible will be utilized to continue the streetscape.
- Building Façade very clear, translucent glass will be light blue, non-reflective, with a clear view into the building. Façade to include a bar design accent.
- Mechanical Penthouse mechanical space has yet to be designed but architects
 will strive to make this element more decorative. South elevations will be
 provided to the URC when they are completed.

Attorney Goldberg noted that a model would be needed for the approval's process. It is anticipated that the Board of Representatives' Land Use Committee will review the proposed LDA this month.
