- 1. Commissioner McMullen called the meeting to order at 5:08pm. Later in the meeting, Commissioners Bowser and Lane joined the meeting.
- 2. The Committee reviewed the following charge: C1-80-5 Board of Education having terms for BOE members be four years. The Committee voted 4-0 in favor to bring this to the full Commission meeting December 14, 2022.
- 3. The Committee reviewed the following charge: C5-20-2 City Departments/Legal -The Committee reviewed in detail whether the years of experience for Corporation Counsel and (C1-90-1) assigned council should be uniform. The Committee agreed 10 years across the board. The Committee voted 4-0-0 in favor to bring this to our regular meeting December 14,2022.

- 7. The Committee agreed and approved the meeting dates going forward for the 2023 calendar year. The Committee voted 4-0-0 in favor
- 8. The Committee agreed and voted to move the optional action items or referral to the regular meeting on December 14, 2022. The vote was 4-0-0 in favor and will be discussed at the regular meeting on December 14, 2022.
