- A: Municipal
- Q: Will the City consider projects that are looking for a VNM Host Customer, but otherwise already have site control, have applied for interconnection, and are submitting into the Year 9 ZREC solicitation in June 2020?
- A: Yes
- Q: Will the City be swapping winning projects with the ones that they already have used to reserve 8 MW on the VNM queue, assuming the projects are similar?
- A: If Eversource permits. Otherwise we would need to do a new application.

All other terms and conditions of RFP No. 802 remain the same.
