The key components of the report focused on member population, assets and assumptions. Each component was reviewed and no changes were proposed. The valuation data from 2023 would be provided as soon as available.

ii. Monthly Report – Joe DePalma, Jr., Principal Custody Solutions

Mr. DePalma, Jr. reviewed the Administrative Report for the period ending February 28, 2023, which included financials for the Fund, such as opening balance, contributions, distributions, fees and expenses. According to the report, the Fund had a loss for the month, but an overall gain for the fiscal year to date. Lastly, Mr. DePalma reported that the Fund has been maintaining a healthy cash balance, which will cover liability payments for the next four months.
