The Chairwoman stated the South End Historic District website is up and the City has paid invoices outstanding back to January.

Reviewed status of 16 Remington Avenue application. The property owner tore down a historic home improperly without a demolition permit, and proceeded to submit an application for a new structure that includes a historic preservation bonus. The proposal with the historic preservation bonus dominates the site and is out of character with newly renovated historic adjoining residential structure. The application is pending before the Zoning Board.
