The attached contract with Shock Electrical Contractors, Inc. for street light maintenance and administration now requires Board approvals because the fees have exceeded \$100,000.00 per year. If agreeable, please forward this email and the attached Contract Documents to the City's Board of Finance and Board of representatives for consideration.

Shock is paid hourly for maintenance work. Total annual fees were estimated at \$90,000.00 to \$95,000.00 per year when we entered into this contract a little over a year ago. See my April 2022 email to you below. Fees for the first year were approximately \$108,000.00 and will likely be higher, with a limit of \$120,000.00, for the 2nd and 3rd year of this contract. The reason being that we are replacing more equipment than expected due to the age of the equipment and Eversource's replacement requirements.
