- Public Safety Need for Civilianized 911 Center




## TIMOTHY SHAW, CHIEF OF POLICE, STAMFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT

- Second largest City with over 135,000 residents
- Stamford is one of the last cities in the State that has not civilianized its ECC
- The following municipalities have civilianized their ECCs:
  - Hartford, Bridgeport, Norwalk, New Haven, New Britain, Waterbury, and Westport/Fairfield
- This reconfiguration positions the City for future regionalization
