**Subject:** Amendment No. 1 to BBS-Stamford Contract for Window-Floor Replacement Design at Springdale School (RFP 807)

Good afternoon Your Honor,

Attached is an Amendment 1 to the City's contract with BBS Architects & Engineers, PC for design services for window and floor replacement at Springdale Elementary School (City RFP No. 807). If agreeable, please forward this email and its attachments to City's Board of Finance and Board of Representatives for consideration/approval as this amendment increases the total fees of the contract to over \$100,000.00.

This Amendment splits the phase of the work, updates the City's budget and revises the project schedule. The phases shall now be (1) window and masonry reconstruction, and (2) floor replacement. Phase 1 construction will commence the day after the last day of the 2023/2024 school year and be substantially completed before the start of the 2024/2025 school year. Phase 2 construction will commence the day after the 2024/2025 school year and be substantially completed before the start of the 2025/2026 school year. The original construction cost estimates for the window and floor replacement project ranged from \$750,000.00 (City) to \$1,183,000.00 (BBS). The corresponding estimated BBS fee range was, therefore, \$65,625.00 to \$99,167.00 (See my 8/6/2021 email to you below). The current construction budget now totals \$2,058,620.00 (\$1,210,589.00 window/masonry + \$848,031.00 floor). The corresponding estimated BBS fee is now, therefore, estimated at a total of \$157,427.00 (7.4% of the window/masonry + 8% of the floor). Board approvals are now required as the total contract fee exceeds \$100,000.00.
