A/C Conklin informed the Commission about the NOC arrest on July 7, 2023 at the fireworks of a male who was sitting on the beach and had a loaded hand gun in his backpack and 6.5 grams of crack cocaine. He was taken into custody without any incident. Gun was stolen out of Pennsylvania.

July 5, 2023 helped Norwalk PD with a kidnapping and DV incident. Suspect got onto I-95coming into Stamford, our department set up cars to slow down traffic. Suspect crashed into one of our PD vehicles, ran and jumped off I-95 onto Washington Blvd. Suspect was arrested.

On the midnight shift 2 weeks ago Yonkers PD attempted to arrest a murder suspect in Stamford at the Super 8 Motel. Sgt. R. Connelly and Sgt. K. Lynch and out SRT team set up perimeter and were able to arrest the murder suspect and 2 other suspects. Gun was recovered.

Commissioner Bass spoke how he appreciated the accolades the PD is receiving and the Commission is very proud of the officers serving the community but especially getting the job done without any one getting hurt.
