- Scalzi Park tennis curts re-lamp was completed on September 13, 2023. Upgraded (25) lights.
- City playground inspections are to be done by October which will give us a current report on all City playgrounds within the parks.

- Cove Island Park marina pilings are being inspected and the Engineering Department is awaiting a summary report on current conditions and recommended replacements to be advanced with the next phase of the marina dredging.

- Special Olympics of CT held a very successful event at Scalzi Park Bocce court on September 9 & 10, 2023.
- Beach/Park Attendants have completed their season within the parks.
- Northern Park attendants continue to monitor areas into the fall season per allocated budget.
- Awaiting dog park upgrades at Courtland Avenue from landscape architect.
- Hurricane barrier maintenance is in progress with the WPCA contract.
- Scalzi Park Bocci court upgrade: Awaiting work scope and design plan.
- Working on FY 2023-2024 Capital Park submissions which is due October 13, 2023.
- Hired (1) Parks Maintenance Worker: Shawn Urbano to start October 2, 2023. Shawn has been a park seasonal for 8 years and this past year has been a provisional worker for the vacancy.
- Interviews to be scheduled for (1) Parks Maintenance Worker vacancy position.
- Cove Island Park Tram completed its season on Labor Day.
- Summer lifeguards at our beaches completed the season on Labor Day.
- Cummings Park standalone pickleball court update: Received price proposals for the project by (3) companies and will be working with the administration for a donation to support the game court project.
- Park permits and activity to be sent weekly from the Cashier and Permitting Department which will highlight approved activity. Recreation is looking to launch "Live" calendar to website.
- Flat-roof construction project started September 8, 2023 at Terry Conner Rink (TCR) and will take approximately one-month to completion.
- September skating lessons started for TCR on September 5, 2023.
- Recreation Fall registration started on September 5, 2023. Classes started this week, September 18, 2023 and the remainder of classes will begin next Monday, September 25, 2023.
- Fall Ball schedules for youth baseball and softball have begun.
- Adult Recreational leagues summer playoffs have completed, Fall Ball to start simultaneously for softball, kickball and indoor volleyball.
- Fall swim lessons started September 12, 2023.
