

Dear Mr. Owens,

The Board of Ethics has reviewed the functional relationship of your position as an employee of Neighborhood Housing Services of Stamford, Inc. (NHS) and your position as an elected member of the Stamford Board of Representatives.

It is our opinion that your holding of both positions at the same time does not, in and of itself, constitute a violation of the Stamford Code of Ethics. However, the Board is of the opinion that as a member of the Board of Representatives you should abstain from any debate and voting on matters that specifically relate to NHS. This would include considerations and determinations as to the amount of city funds to be made available for grants to NHS activities.
