Dear Mr. Cohen:

Your letter of July 22, 1987 to Corporation Counsel Mary Sommer, concerning employment by your firm of Assistant Corporation Counsel Eric L. Reinken, was referred to the Board of Ethics for review.

In your letter, you state that Mr. Reinken would be screened from all cases in which he actively participated on behalf of the City as well as other cases currently pending in which he has not been involved. You add that you would also comply with any provisions of the Code of Ethics which might apply in Mr. Reinken's case.

The Board of Ethics considered this matter and concluded as follows:

- 1) The four steps outlined in your letter are proper and accepted by the Board.
- 2) To comply with the Ethics Code, the following requirements apply to Mr. Reinken:
  - a) Re Category I cases in which he has been involved: Section 9Ac permanently prohibits Mr. Reinken from any involvement.
  - b) Re Category II cases now pending in which Mr. Reinken has not been involved: Section 9Ad permits his involvement after one year from the date of his employment.
  - c) Re Category III cases that may arise after Mr. Reinken's employment: Section 9Ab forbids his involvement with the Law Department for a period of one year.

By complying with the above, your firm may now proceed to hire Mr. Reinken.
