- Operation Safe House: Between August and September 3 or 4 task force inspections have been conducted in order to identify unsafe housing throughout the city. The task force is comprised of the Fire Marshal's office, Police, Zoning and other agencies.
- Advisory letters and condemnation orders have been issued for units that are uninhabitable. The process begins with complaints logged into VEOCI regarding unsafe housing.
- Family Day Took place September 30, 2023. After 5 years Stamford is resuming community event and will continue annually.
- Flu Kick off took place on September 30, 2023, during Family Day.
- Social Services: Engaging community on inner workings of fair housing, and Husky enrollment.
- Community Nursing:
- Well Child clinic: conducted 68 physicals, up from 42 last year, and 158 vaccinations, up from 104 last year in an effort to ensure compliance.
- Covid and Flu: Vaccines available at 137 Henry Street Clinic Tuesdays, and Wednesdays 9a to 2p. Covid vaccines for children are being acquired under the Children Program, and the Bridge Access program for uninsured adults.
- School Nursing: 2 new nurses have been added and 1 vacancy remains under School nursing.
