Dear Sir:

The Board of Ethics considered the situation described in your letter of May 21, 1986, involving another city agency with which your wife is associated. It is the opinion of the Board of Ethics that you would not be in conflict and may participate in all aspects of your board's hearings on this issue, on which another city agency will be taking a position before your board.

This opinion is based on the fact that your wife is a paid staff member of this agency with no decision or policy-making powers. Since she is expected to espouse her agency's policies, the Board of Ethics agrees with her intent to refrain from participating in any of your board's hearings on this matter, and the Board of Ethics so recommends.
