RESOLUTION

Subject:

Authorize an Agreement between Fairfield Court Housing Corporation (FCHC) and April Housing (April) for the exit of April Housing from Fairfield Court Limited Partnership (FCLP)

Background:

This resolution is to approve the execution of an agreement under which April Housing shall exit FCLP. April is exiting prior to the end of Year 15 of the tax credit partnership. Liabilities and responsibilities normally extending through Year 15 will remain in place until that time.

The proposed agreement calls for a payment by FCHC to April of \$155,000 in exchange for April's 99,9% interest in FCLP. FCLP will also be responsible for payment of the State Controlling Interest Transfer Tax, estimated at \$200,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that:

- 1. The Purchase & Sale Agreement referenced herein is hereby approved subject to review and approval of counsel and all revisions to said Agreement as may be necessary to correct errors, reflect final refinements of the transaction, and respond to requirements of regulators are hereby agreed to.
- 2. The President or Vice President is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute the Agreement and to execute additional documents and take such further actions as may be necessary.
- 3. Further, the President, Vice President, and such other officers and designees of Rippowam Corporation whose signatures may be required, are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute additional documents and take such further actions as may be necessary.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
