RAIN GARDEN NOTES (TYP.):

- AVOID VEHICLE TRAFFIC OVER PROPOSED RAIN GARDEN AREAS IF FEASIBLE. SCARIFIED SUBSOIL AS NEEDED IF SOILS ARE COMPACTED.
- SEED RAIN GARDEN WITH "MOIST MEADOW / RAIN GARDEN MIX" BY PRAIRIE NURSERY (800-476-9453) AT THE METHODS RECOMMENDED BY THE MANUFACTURER. ESTABLISH GOOD VEGETATION COVERAGE FROM SEED MIX IN RAIN GARDEN PRIOR TO RECEIVING STORMWATER RUNOFF TO PREVENT SEEDS FROM BEING WASHED AWAY.
- ROUTINE YEARLY MAINTENANCE OF RAIN GARDEN SHALL INCLUDE THE REMOVAL OF INVASIVE NONNATIVE PLANT SPECIES (BY HAND PULLING OR SPOT HERBICIDE TREATMENTS), RESEEDING BARE AND THINLY VEGETATED AREAS WITH THE SPECIFIED SEED MIXTURE, REMULCHING PLANTINGS AS NEEDED, REMOVAL OF ACCUMULATED SEDIMENT WITHIN BASIN BOTTOM BY HAND, REMOVAL OF LITTER, KEEPING THE OUTLET STRUCTURE FREE OF DEBRIS, AND REMOVAL OF DEAD, DISEASED, OR UNHEALTHY PLANTS.

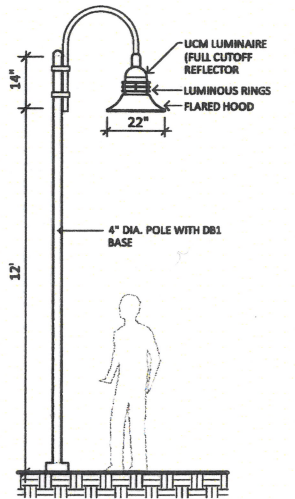

- PLANTING METHODS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE "AMERICAN STANDARDS FOR NURSERY STOCK", LATEST EDITION, AS PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN NURSERY & LANDSCAPE ASSOCIATION.
- SPRAY NEW PLANTINGS IMMEDIATELY AFTER INSTALLATION WITH A WHITE-TAILED DEER REPELLENT AND CONTINUE AS NEEDED TO MAINTAIN PLANTS FREE OF SIGNIFICANT DEER BROWSING. SHIELD NEWLY PLANTED TREE TRUNKS FROM DEER RUBBING WITH TREE TRUNK PROTECTION.
- SEED LAWN AREAS WITH A HIGH QUALITY FESCUE AND BLUEGRASS SEED MIXTURE.

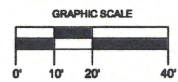
