### Old Business

- 1) Transportation, Traffic & Parking Department Updates
  - a. Construction projects moving along well. Lower Summer and Greenwich/Pulaski.
- 2) Police Department/Public Safety Updates
  - a. Updated crash report from Frank.
  - b. Vision Zero Crash Dashboard Updates.
  - c. Working on increasing Stamford Police Communications Division coordination.

### New Business

- 1) Vision Zero Action Plan Update
  - a. Contract has been approved by all Boards.
  - b. Next meeting (12/5/23) will be the kick off with the Action Plan Consultants.
- 2) Pilot Projects next steps
  - a. Delineator posts have been removed across the City for the winter.
  - b. Looking at crash data to analyze effects of pilot projects.
  - c. Many bump outs will become fully built out in the future.
  - d. Moving away from calling these projects "pilot" to "quick build".
  - e. Looking at traffic data for Washington Blvd and Main St pilot project to analyze next steps.
- 3) LOTCIP Grant Letters of Support
  - a. The City is applying for two CTDOT LOTCIP grants
    - i. Safe Routes to School Crosswalks Enhancements
      1. Crosswalk upgrades around schools. Adams Ave, Toms Road, Holcomb Ave, Arlington and Valley, and Lockwood Ave
    - ii. Bulls Head Pedestrian Safety Upgrades
      1. Sidewalk and crosswalk additions
      2. Rebuilding sidewalks.
  - b. Request for a letter of support from the Task Force was requested and agreed upon.
