Plunge For Elodie

#### **Description of Event:\*** ②

The event is the "Plunge For Elodie" which raises money to find a cure for the devastating disease epidermolysis bullosa. The event was started in 2018 in honor of Elodie Kubik, who was born in Connecticut with this extremely rare disease. Fast forward five years and we have raised \$2M for the EB Research Partnerhsip, funding critical research that will hopefully save Elodie's and other kids lives. The event has 20 global locations between the US, the UK and Australia. Participants raise money in advance and then "take the plunge" into a body of water (these are very quick dips and individuals typically spend 45 seconds or less in the water). Only a portion of attendees actually "plunge" and most are just spectators, the number listed below is our estimate of total attendees, but we anticipate roughly 20-25% of that number will actually plunge, consistent with past years. Any plunger needs to sign a waiver and we pass out bracelets to ensure that only people who have signed waivers plunge. We plan to have both life guards (we have attached one certification but can find additional people if you prefer) and EMS professionals at the event to ensure safety. Plunges happen in waves of 10-15 people to ensure maximum safety. This will be our fifth consecutive year hosting a plunge in Connecticut, but previous plunges have been on a beach that is part of a neighborhood associate and we are looking for a more accessible, permanent home. This is by no means a widely marketed event only to Elodie's elementary school within the Riverside, CT community. Typically, the entire event is less than one hour and we plan a private post-party off site at a restaurant. We do not serve any food, and have volunteers to ensure nothing is left beyond. We anticipate using the property for less than an hour and are willing to work with the city however is helpful. ## Applicant Adherence to Terms and Conditions

- 1. Make loud or disrupting noises, including amplified music.
- 2. Serve or consume intoxicating or alcoholic beverages except beer.
- 3. Use glass bottles or containers of any kind.
- 4. Light fires except in picnic grills or fireplaces placed by the city.
- 5. Refrain from using gas or propane grills.
- 6. Refrain from using moon-walks or inflatables.
- 7. Park in designated area between May 1st and September 30th without a valid parking sticker. Permits are required at Cove Island, Cummings, West Beach, Southfield, Newman Mills/Riverbank, and Dorothy Heroy Park(s).
- 8. Refrain from use of generators. Addtional permit required
- 9. Refrain from possessing alcohol, including beer, after 9:00pm.
- 10. Avoid wanton damage or removal of lawns, trees, shrubs, flowers, benches, bleachers, drinking fountains, or any other property or equipment.
- 11. Discard paper, trash, rubbish, glass, crockery, or metal, only in containers provided by the City for such purposes, and do not discard household debris at any time.
- 12. Do not have an unleashed animal except in a vehicle.
- 13. Refrain from peddling or selling goods, merchandise and food without a City License and Office of Operations permit.
- 14. Refrain from holding mass meetings or public assemblies except with a City Permit.
- 15. Do not drive a vehicle at speeds over 15 miles per hour or to park such vehicles except in areas designated for such purposes.
- 16. Refrain from washing or repairing vehicles in the park.
- 17. Do not play ball or organized games except in areas plainly designated for such activity.
- 18. Do not bathe or swim in restricted areas.
- 19. Refrain from posting signs on tress or other park property.
- 20. Do not disobey posted signs or warnings.
- 21. Do not drive or chip golf balls in a park.
- 22. Do not hunt, trap, or pursue wildlife at any time on public park land.
- 23. Refrain from consuming food or beverages on artificial turf.

9:25 – 9:40 – Plunge!


9:40 – 9:50 – Participants Exit
