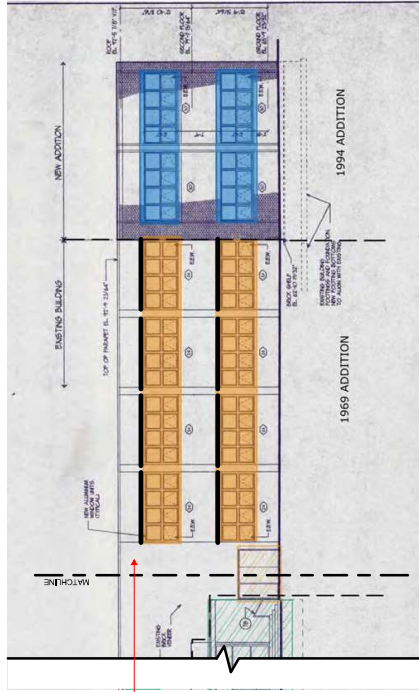
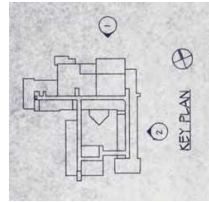
SECOND FLOOR PLAN - DEMOLITION
