In accordance with the Camera Review Committee's Policies and Procedures, Section 7, please accept this letter as a request from the Transportation, Traffic and Parking Department, for an additional Blue Light Emergency Tower.

Dorothy Heroy Park is frequently visited by residents and families throughout the year. We believe that the addition of a Blue Light Tower would increase security and create an additional presence at the park. The location of the tower will be based on park usage, topography, and the experience provided by the City of Stamford and the Stamford Police Department.

Blue Light Emergency Towers are installed to improve safety and act as a security precaution in Stamford parks. By having these highly visible, easily accessible phones with cameras, the park goers will be reassured that they can summon police, fire or medical assistance immediately.

We are requesting that this camera would be Surveillance Level 2 (disclosed Public Surveillance Cameras without a Public Feed and without Monitored Surveillance or without pre-authorized Monitored Surveillance less than 8 hours per week)
