The Parks mentioned above are frequently visited by residents and families throughout the year. We believe that the addition of these Blue Light Tower locations would increase security and create an additional presence at the park. The location of the tower will be based on park usage, topography, and the experience provided by the City of Stamford and the Stamford Police Department.
