Part A - Description of Request

In reviewing the water bill for the Scale House / Transfer Station account, the Engineering Department noticed that the water usage was significantly higher than normal, which led to believe that there was a leak in the system. Based on this, the water bill is significantly more. To address this matter as quickly as possible, Aquarion Water Company recommended vendors; AJ Penna and CT Professional Water Services, to resolve this issue in an expedient manner.

CT Professional Water Services has detected a leak at the Scale House, which is currently inaccessible as it is located under the concrete ramp to the Transfer Station.
