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Pursuant to emergency powers as set forth in Connecticut General Statute Section 28-8a and Section C3-10-10 of the Charter of the City of Stamford, I hereby issue the following Executive Order.

MAYOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER RE: PROCEDURES FOR CITY EMPLOYEES WITH POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULTS

This policy applies to all City employees upon receipt and/or notification of a positive COVID-19 test result.

- The employee must notify their department supervisor immediately.
- The employee must leave the work location immediately (unless they are working remotely);
 and
- The employee must not report to their regular work location until the employee receives medical clearance to return to work.
- If the employee is working remotely and asymptomatic, they may continue working.
- Whether working remotely or not, if symptomatic, the employee should contact a health care provider.
 - If a health care provider directs the employee to not report to work, the employee must notify the department supervisor and apply for appropriate leave as per previously issued City COVID-19 policies.

In addition:

- Employees who have symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, dry cough, shortness of breath) and/or a positive test result should 1) notify the department supervisor, 2) not report to work at any City of Stamford worksite, and 3) immediately contact a health care provider of choice.
- Failure to follow this directive will be considered serious misconduct and the employee will be subject to disciplinary action.
