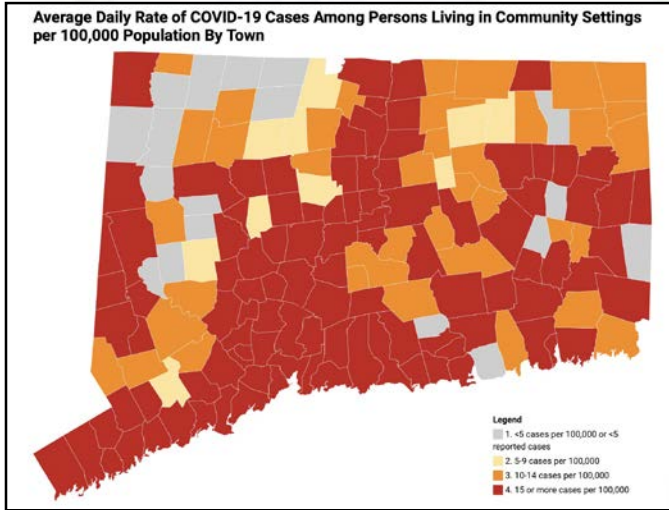

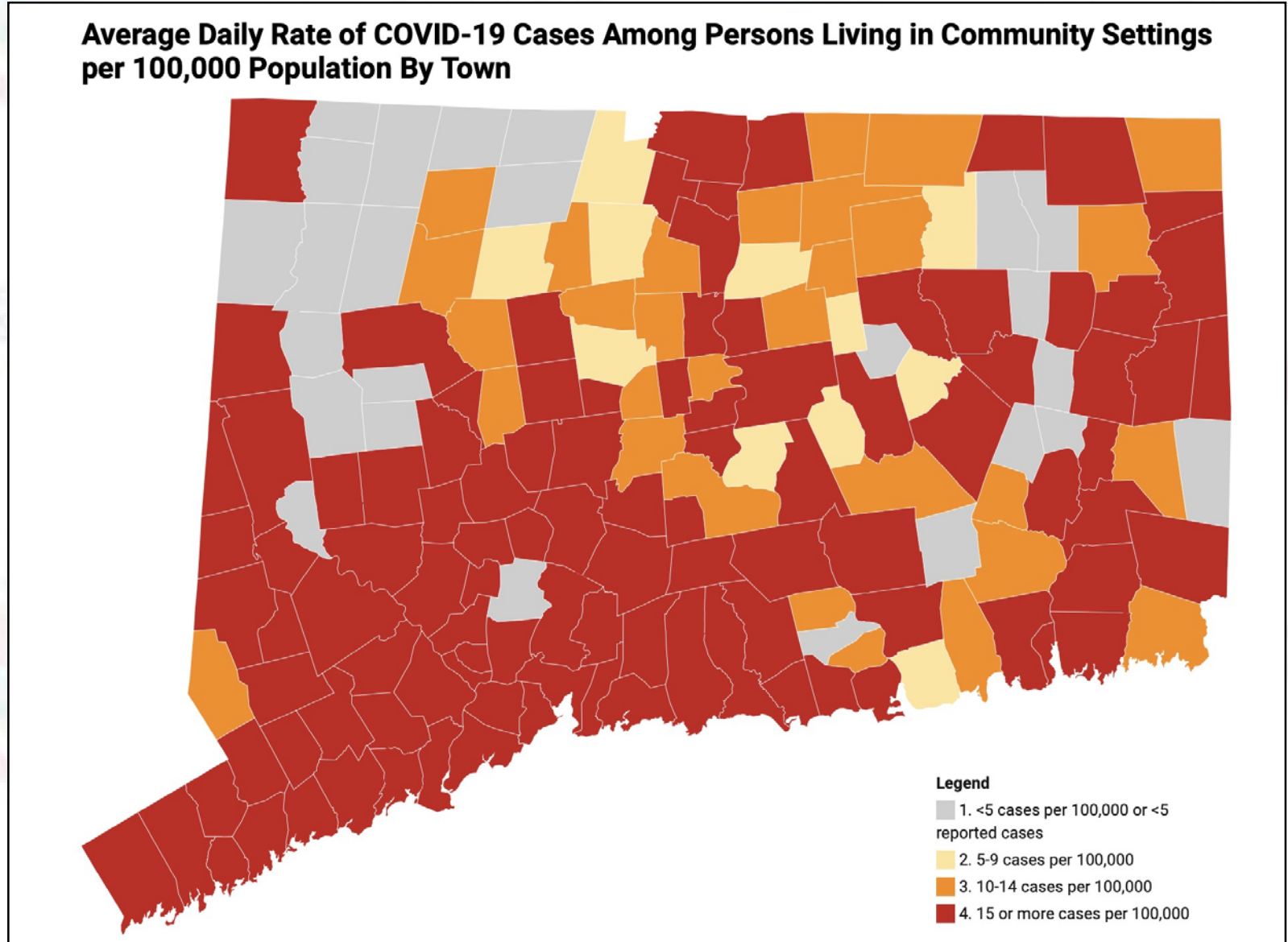

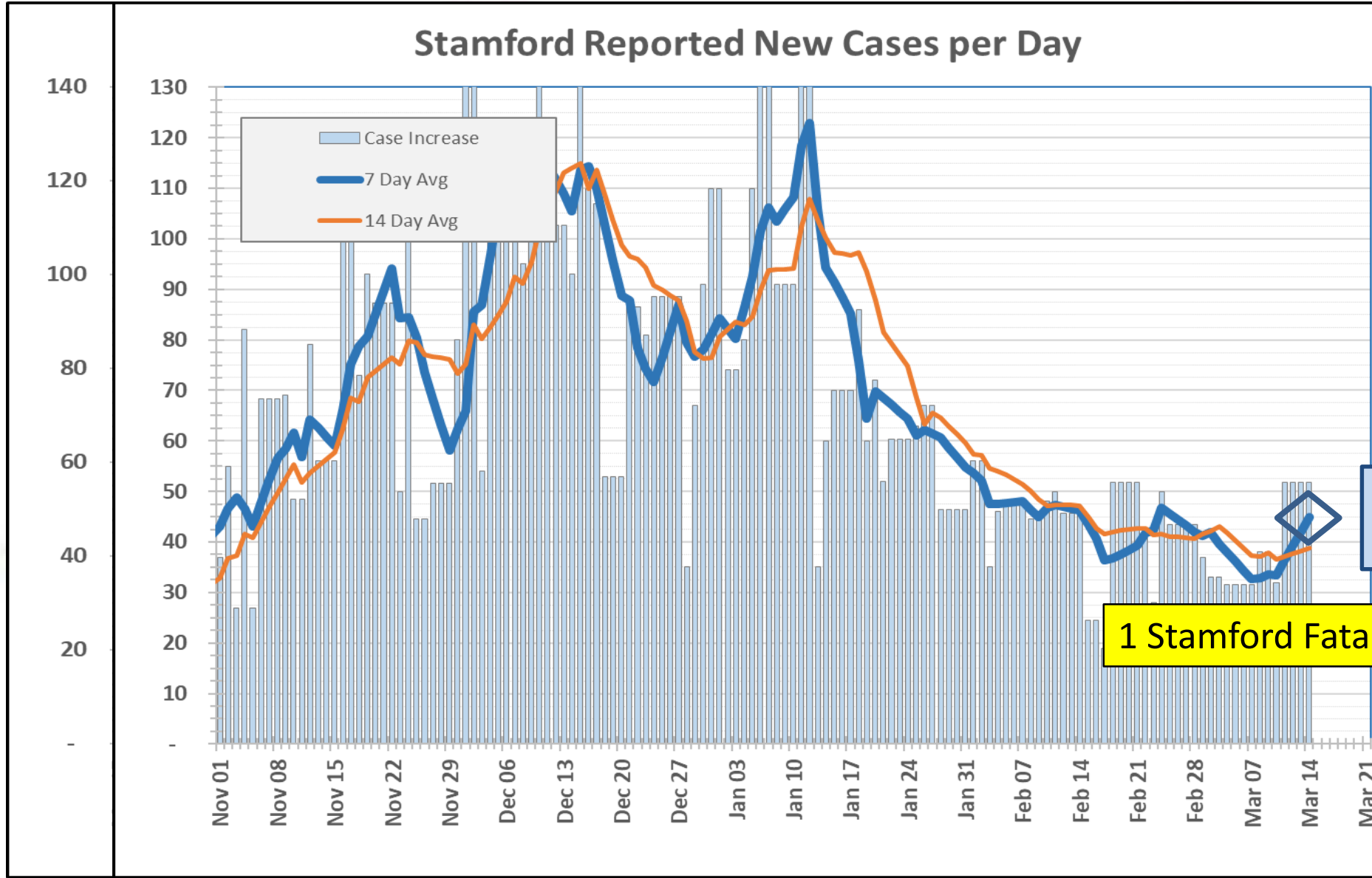

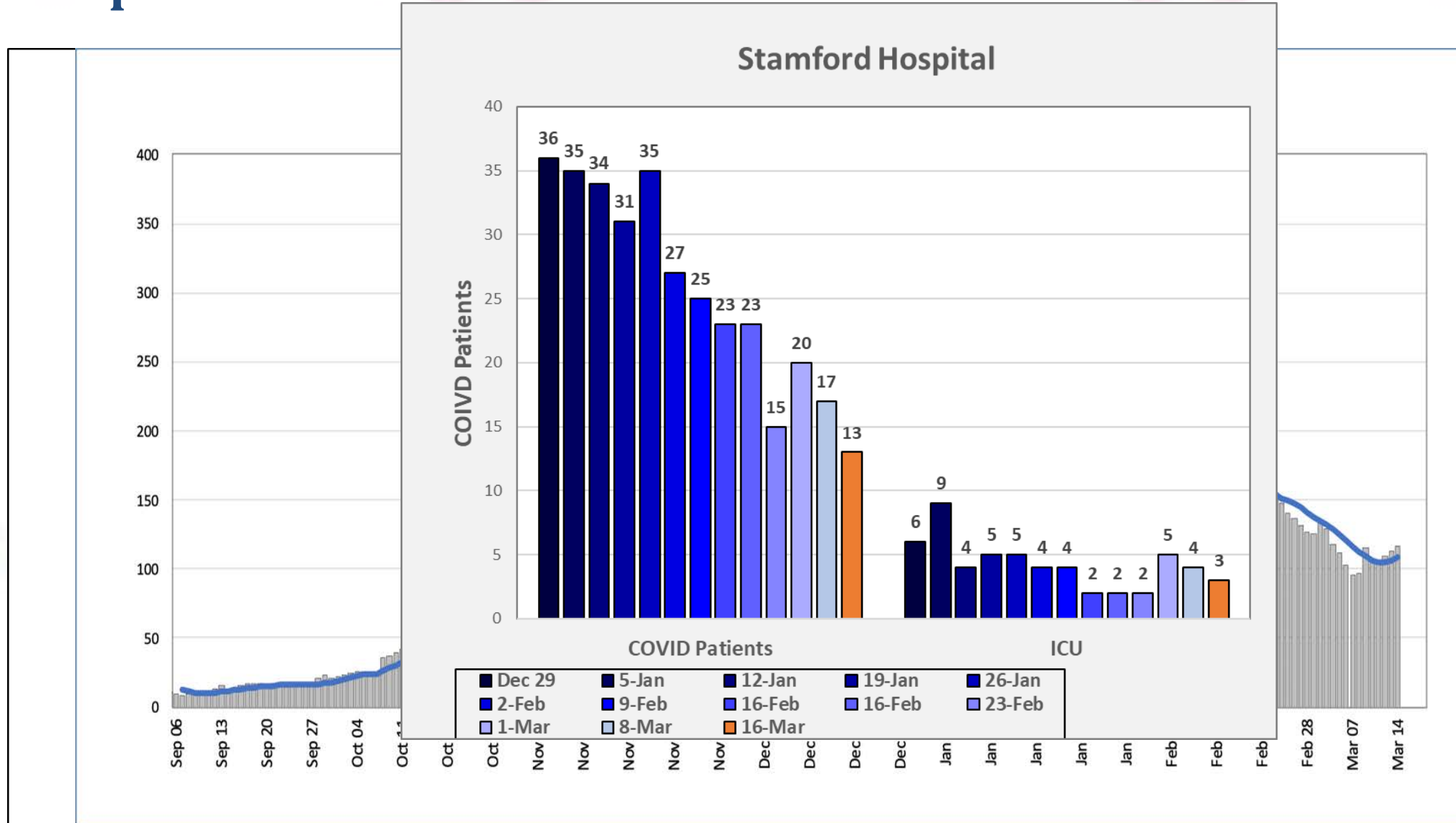

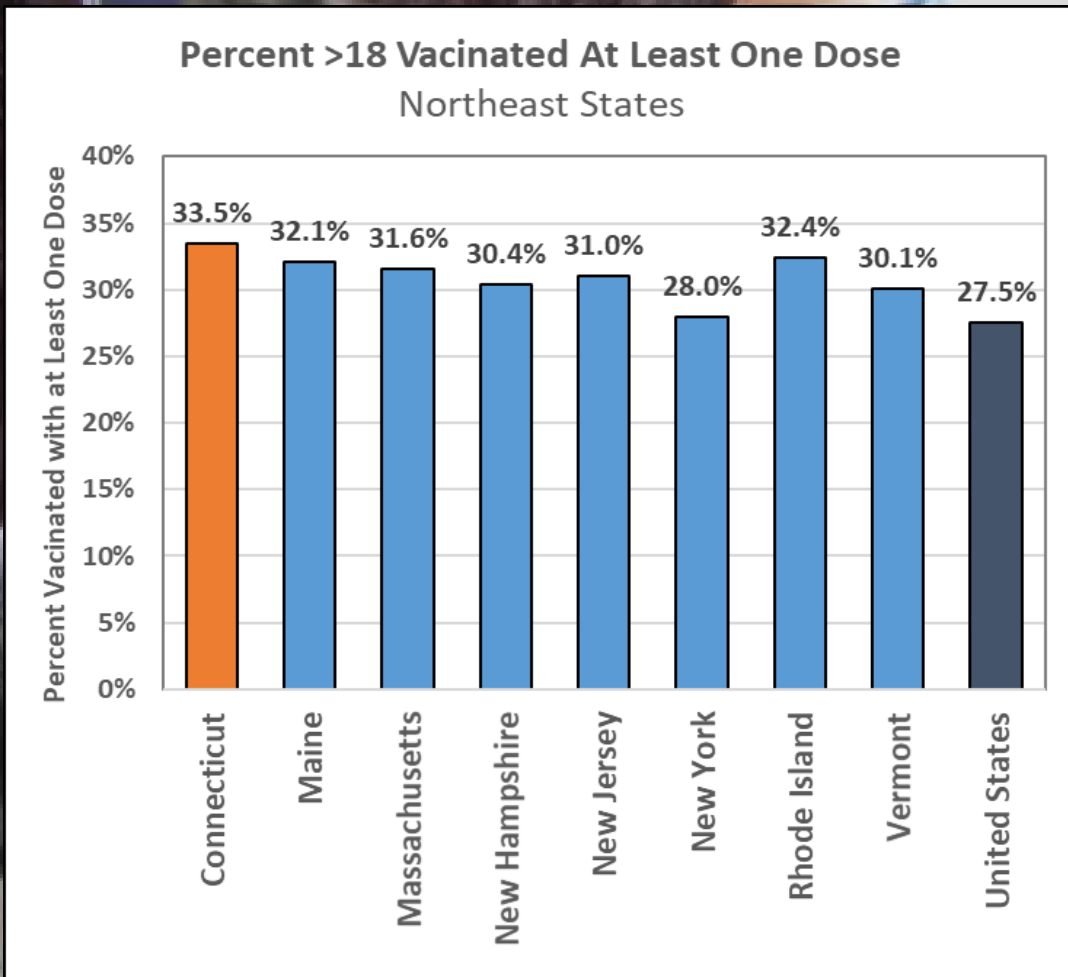

Hospitalization Rate

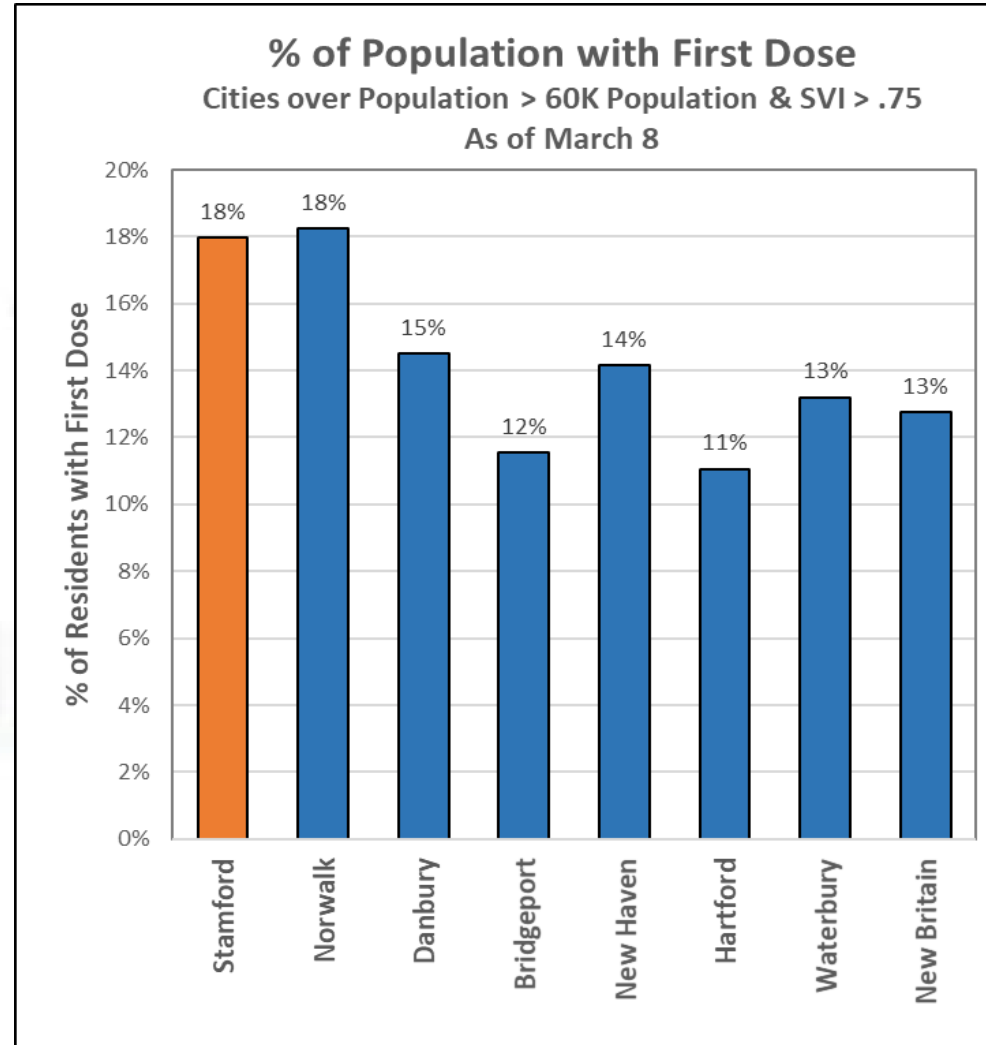
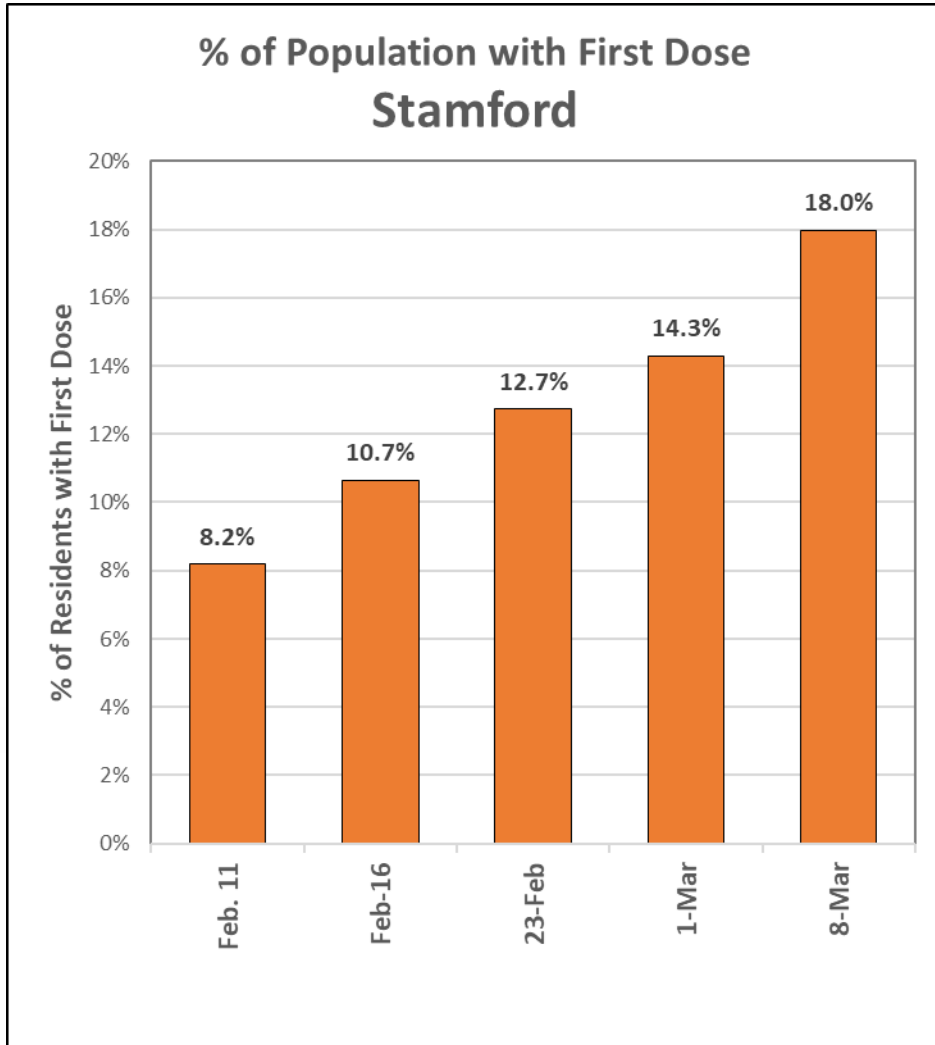


State of Connecticut: Covid 19 Vaccination Rate

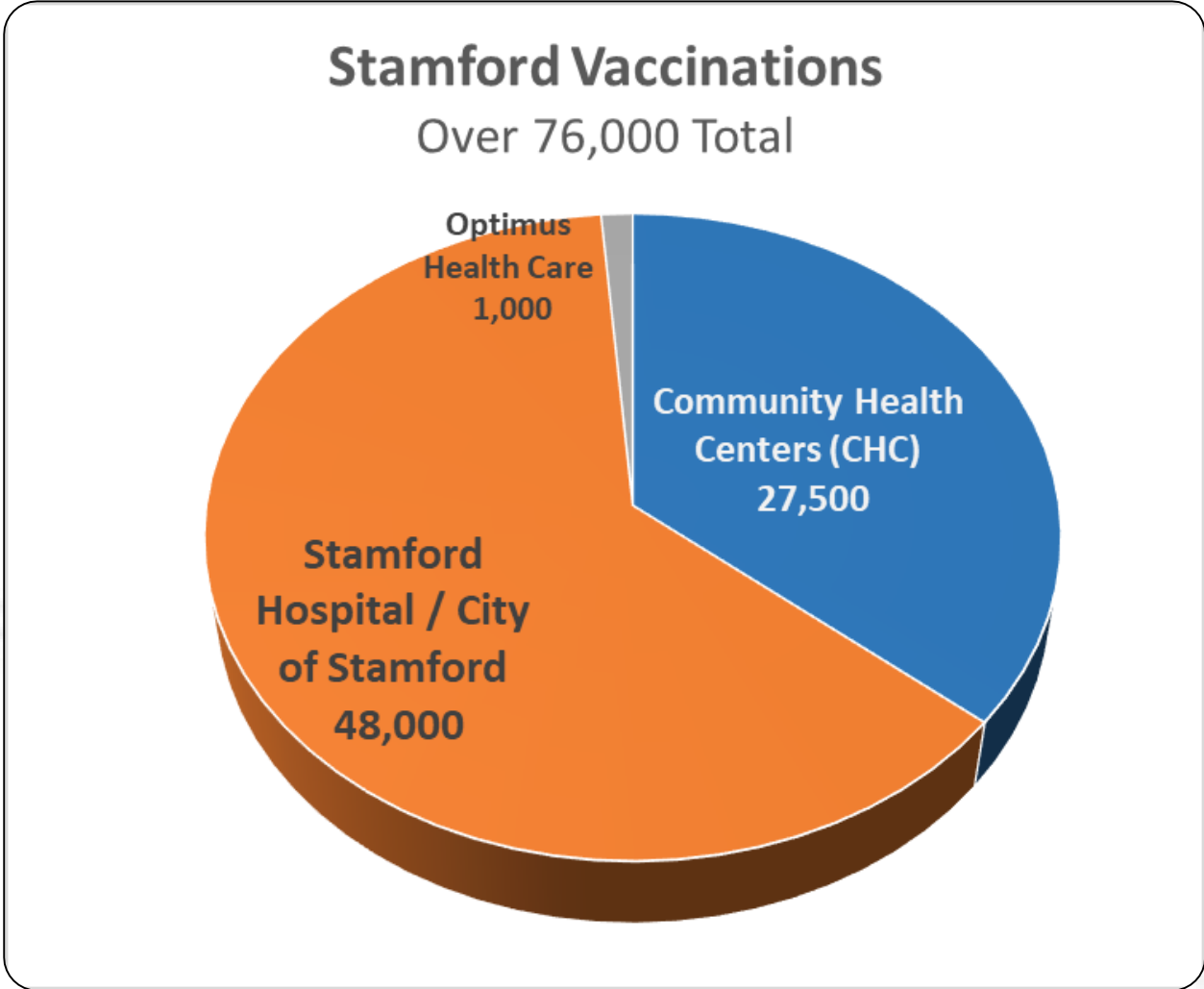

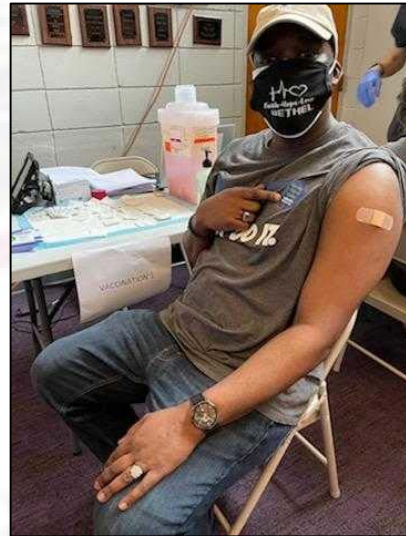

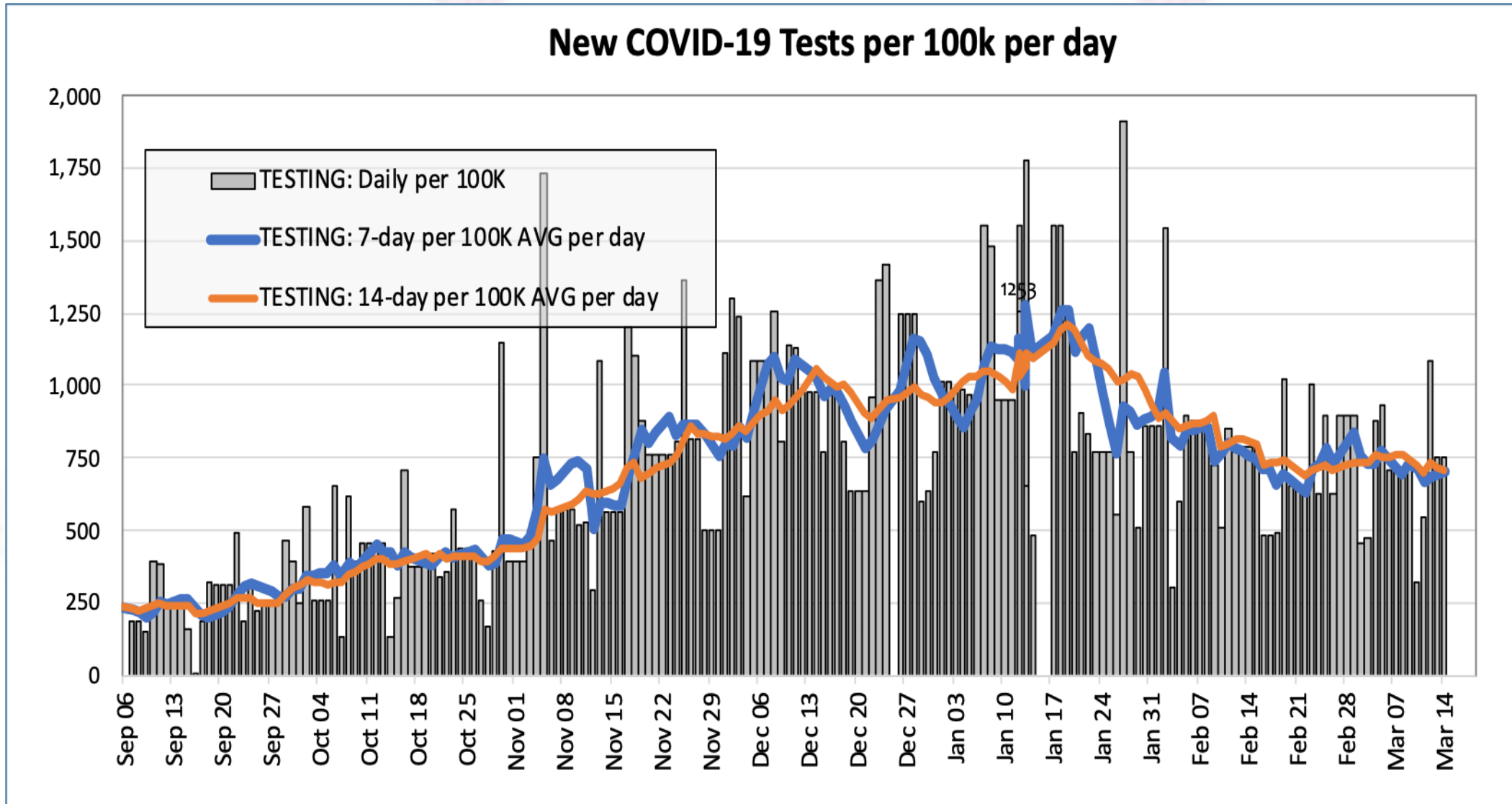
