


State of the City: COVID19 Case Trends






State of the City: COVID19 Hospitalization Rate






State of Connecticut: Covid 19 Vaccination Rate





- Hybrid high school plans for five-days-a-week, inperson
 - Added lunch wave to keep socially distant
 - Full-day schedule
 - Parent survey of 100% in-person v 100% remote
 - Deadline Wednesday
 - Five-day in-person to begin April 19
- COVID-19 testing available
- Educators prioritized for vaccination
- High school seniors to be vaccinated
