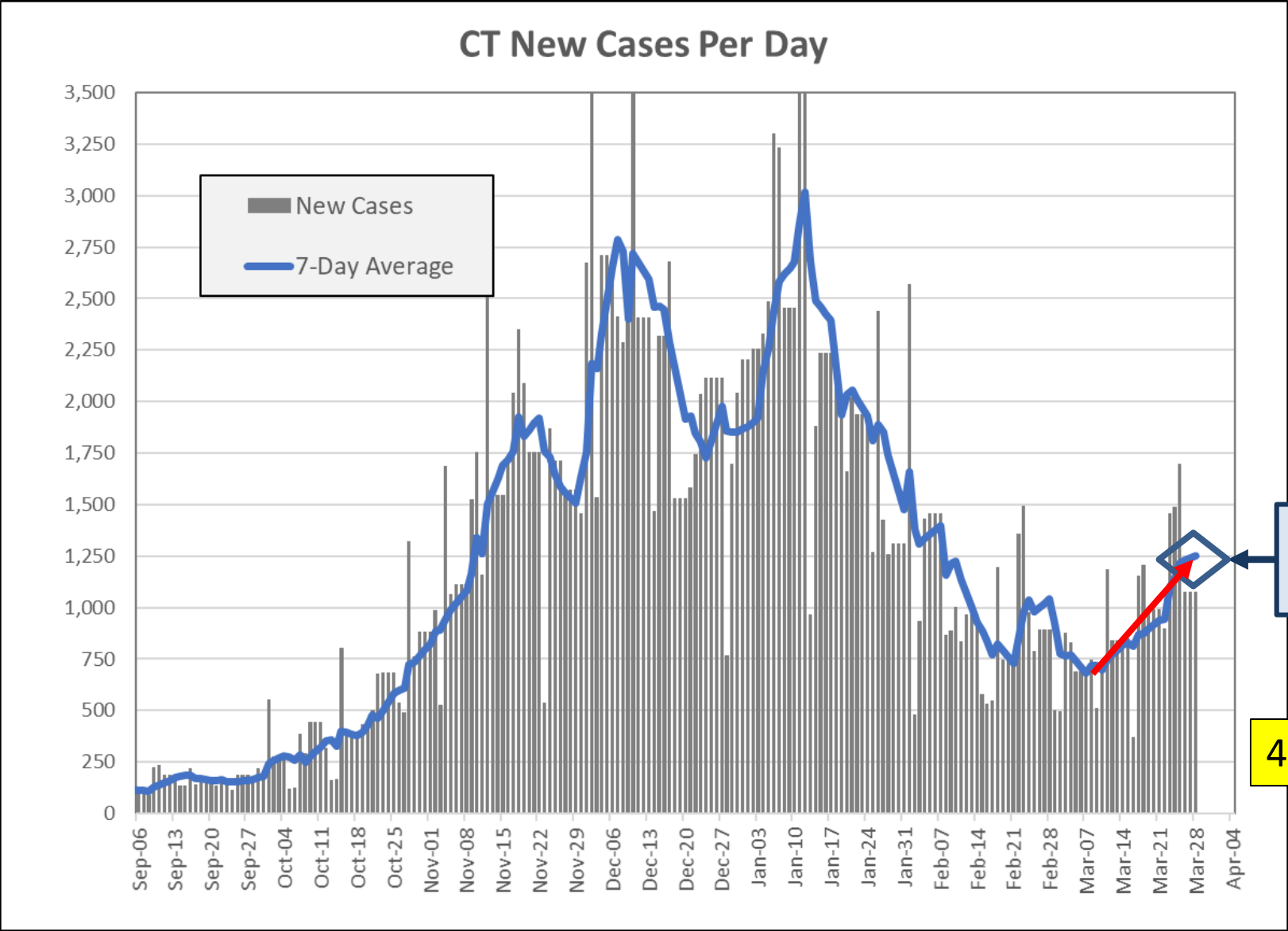

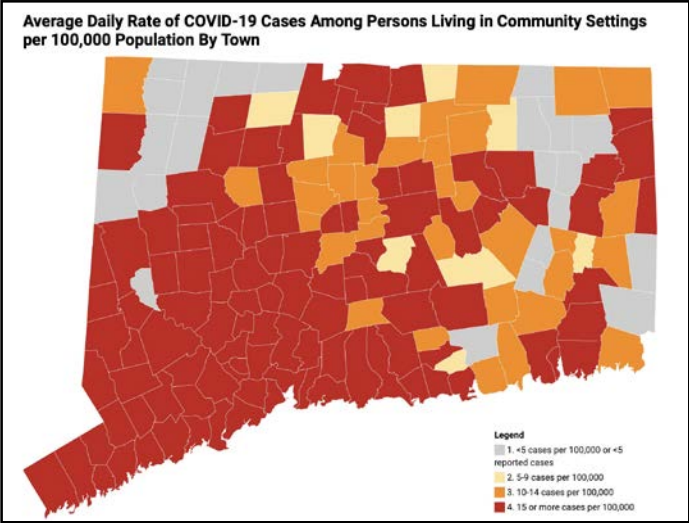

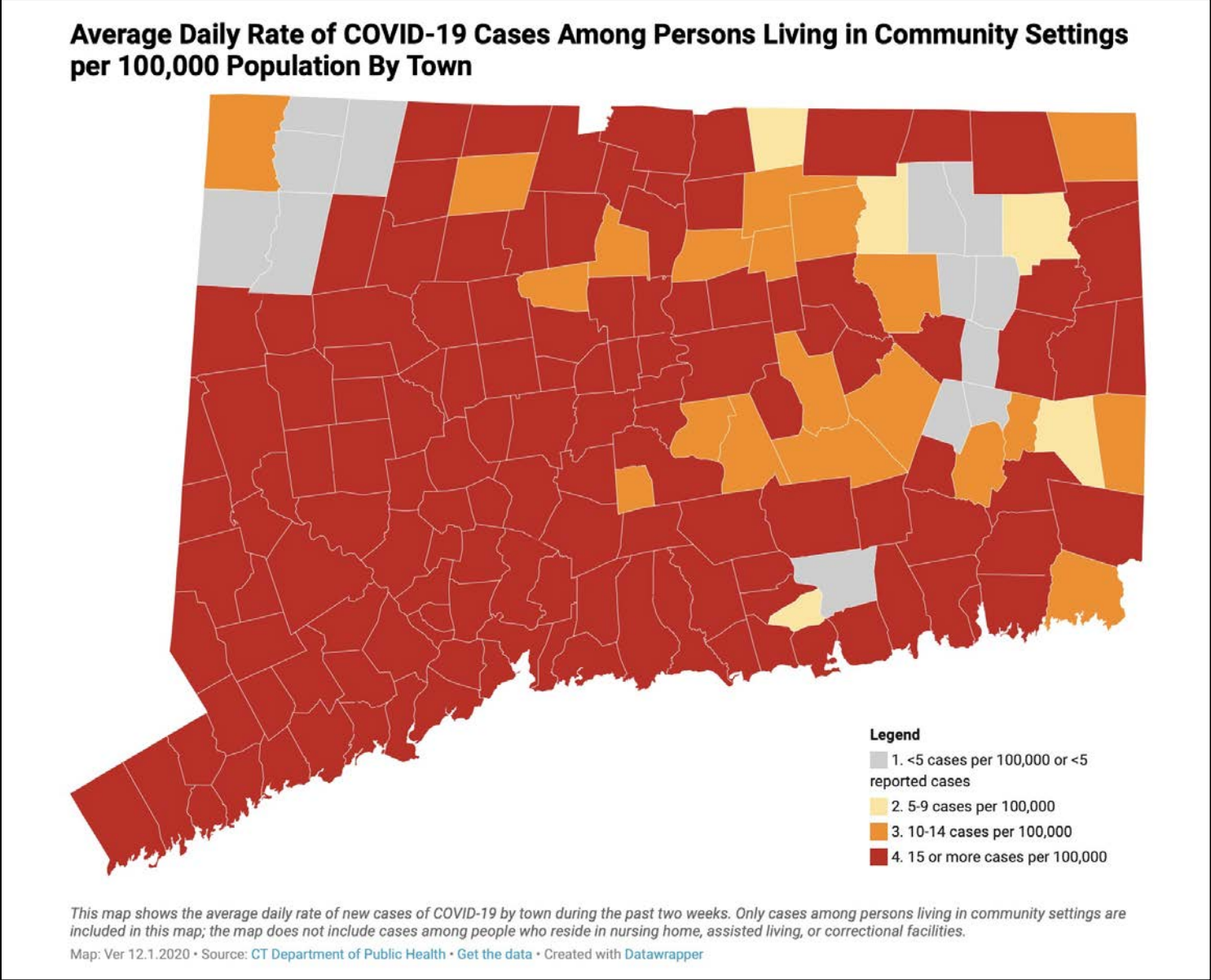

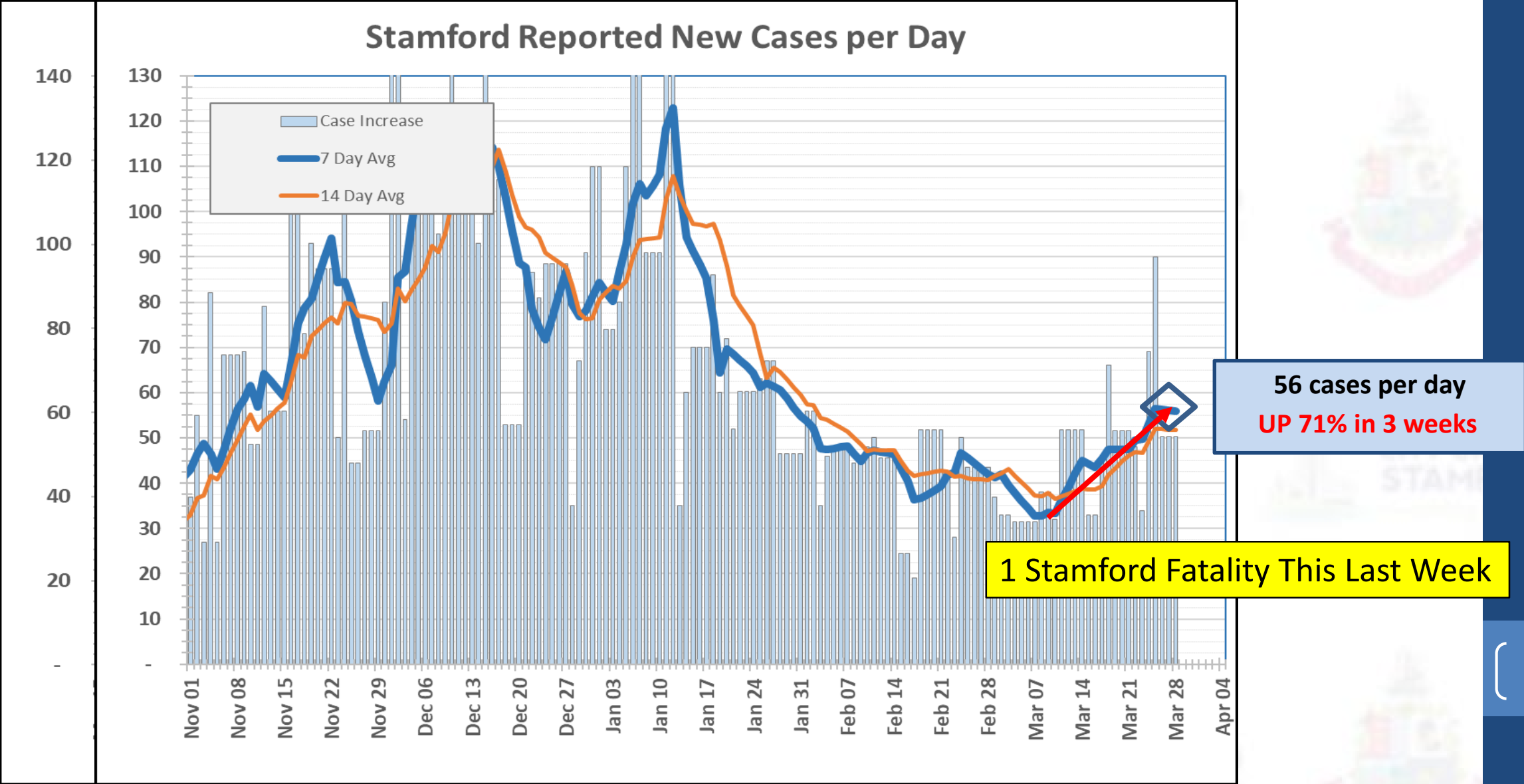

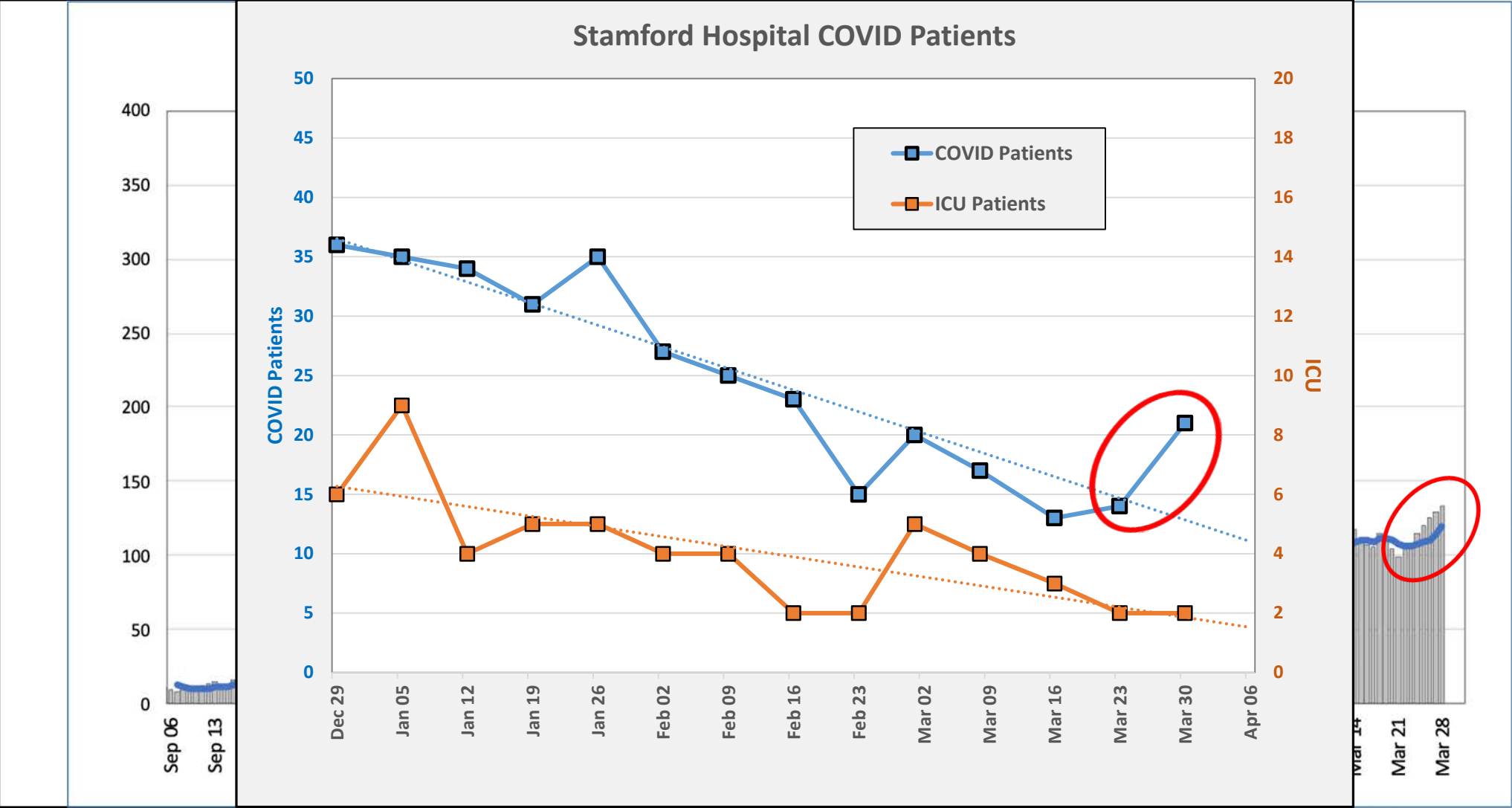

Case Trends

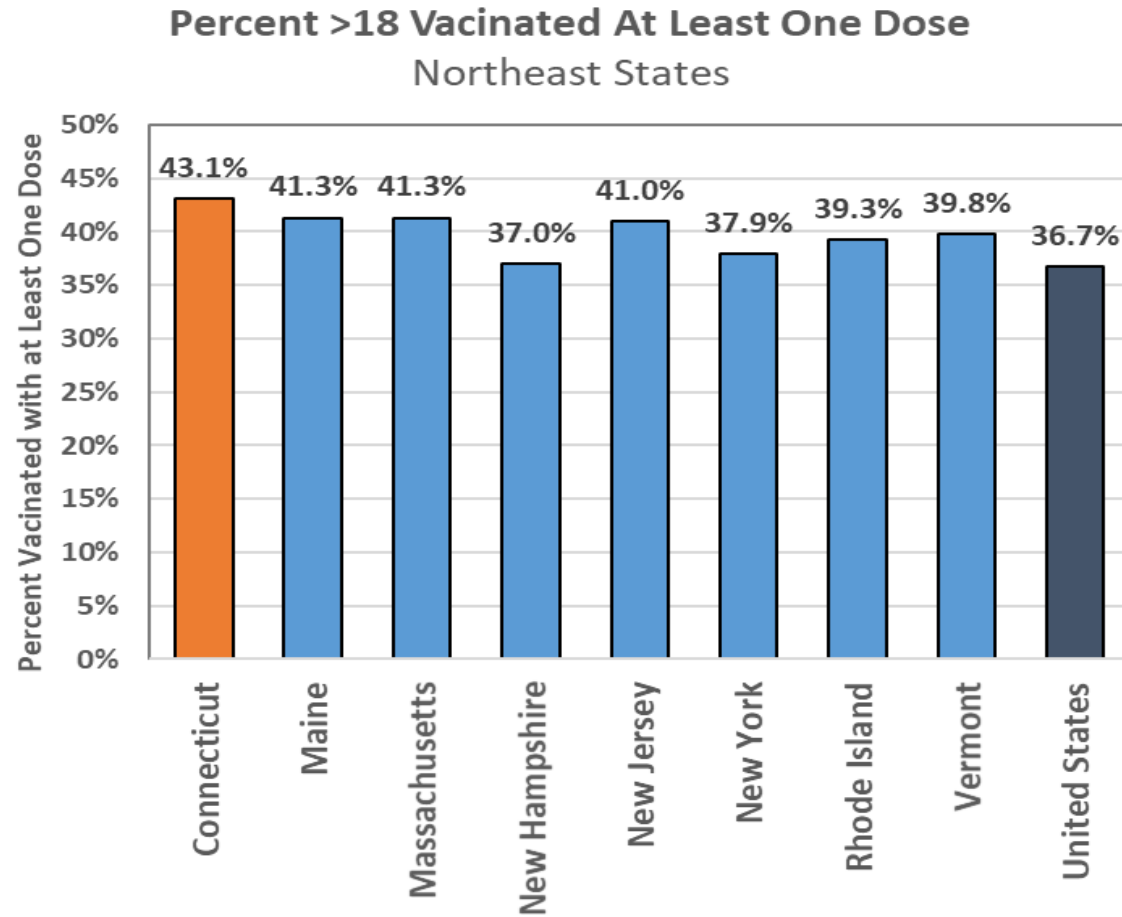

State of Connecticut: Covid 19 Vaccination Rate

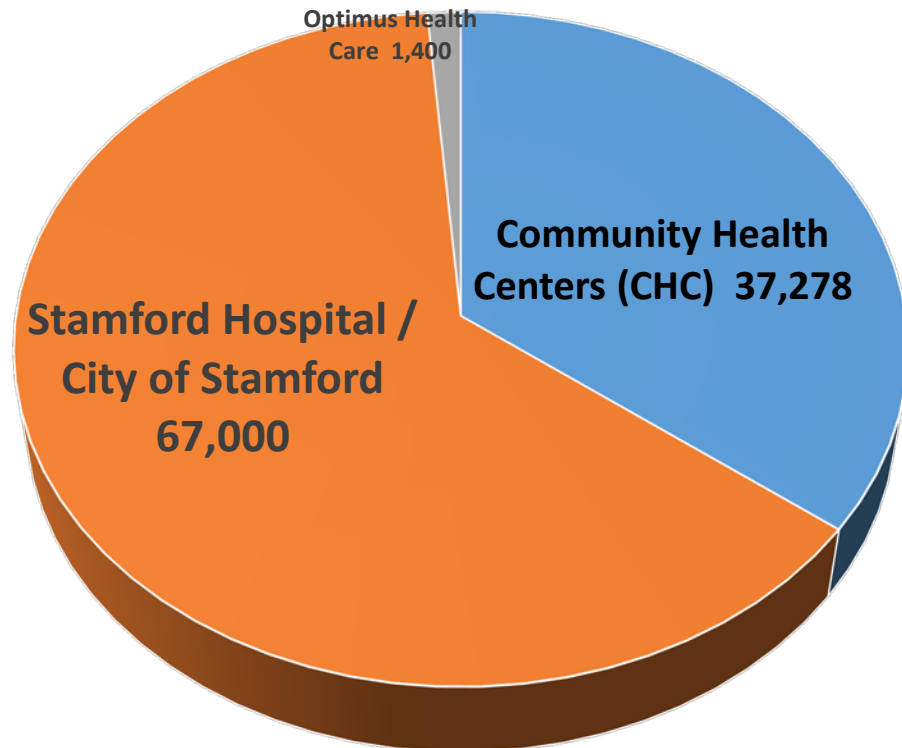

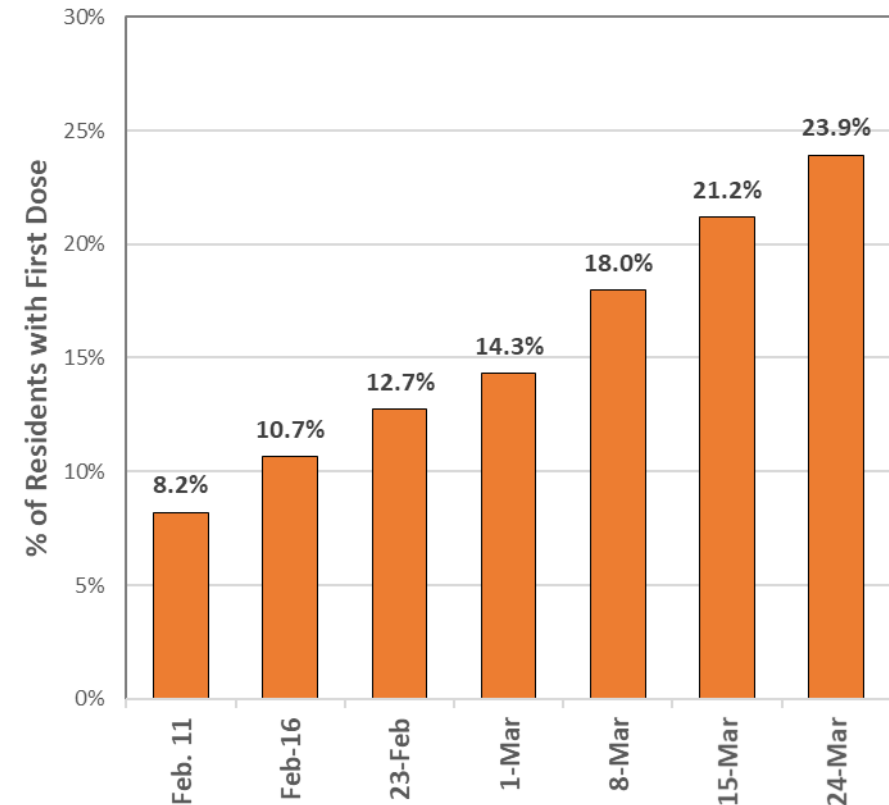

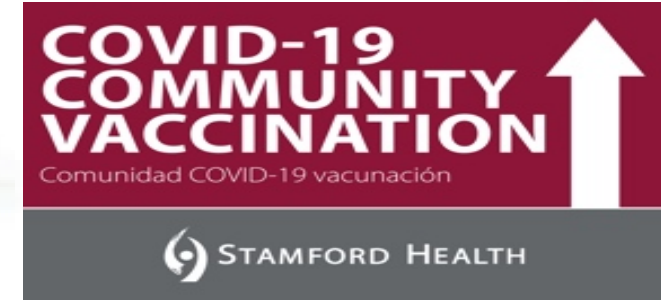

 - Full-day schedule
 - Parent survey of 100% in-person v 100% remote
 - Deadline Wednesday
 - Five-day in-person to begin April 19

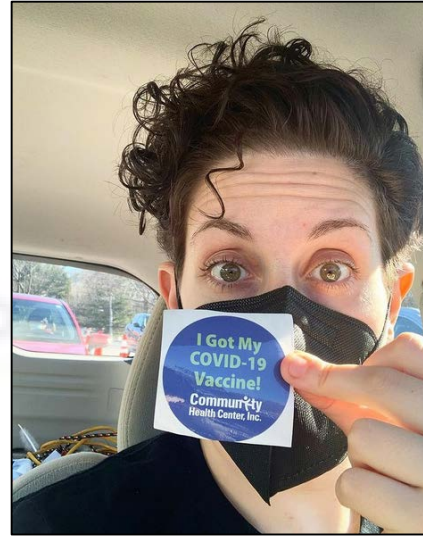

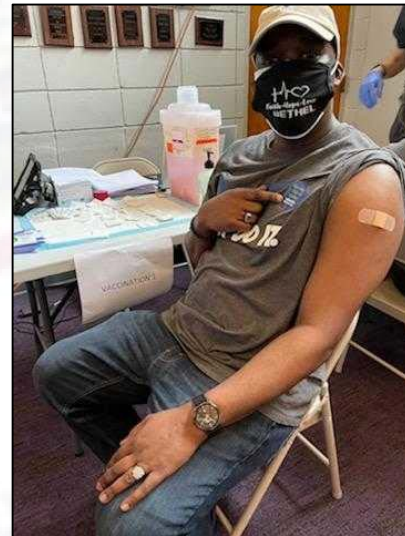
