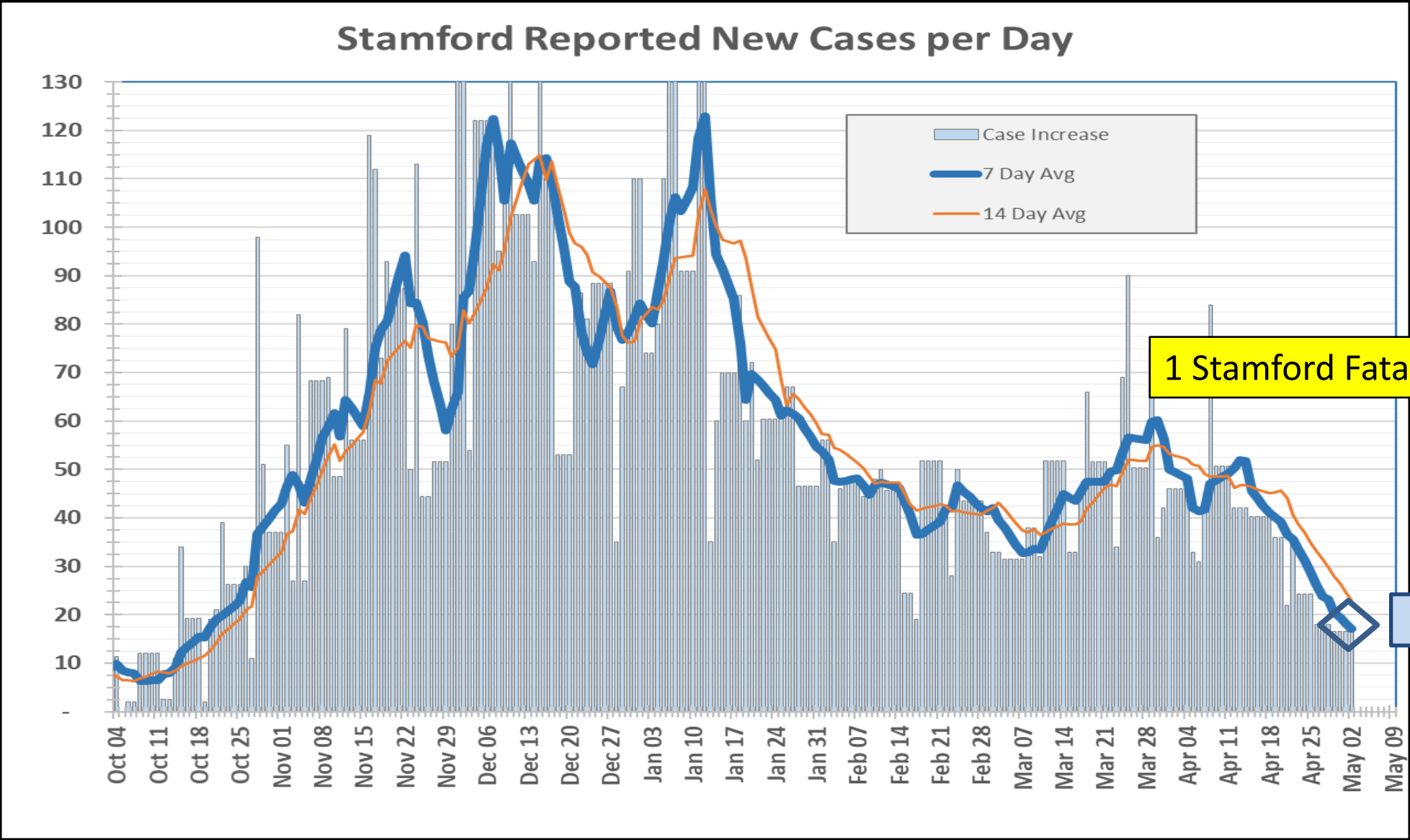

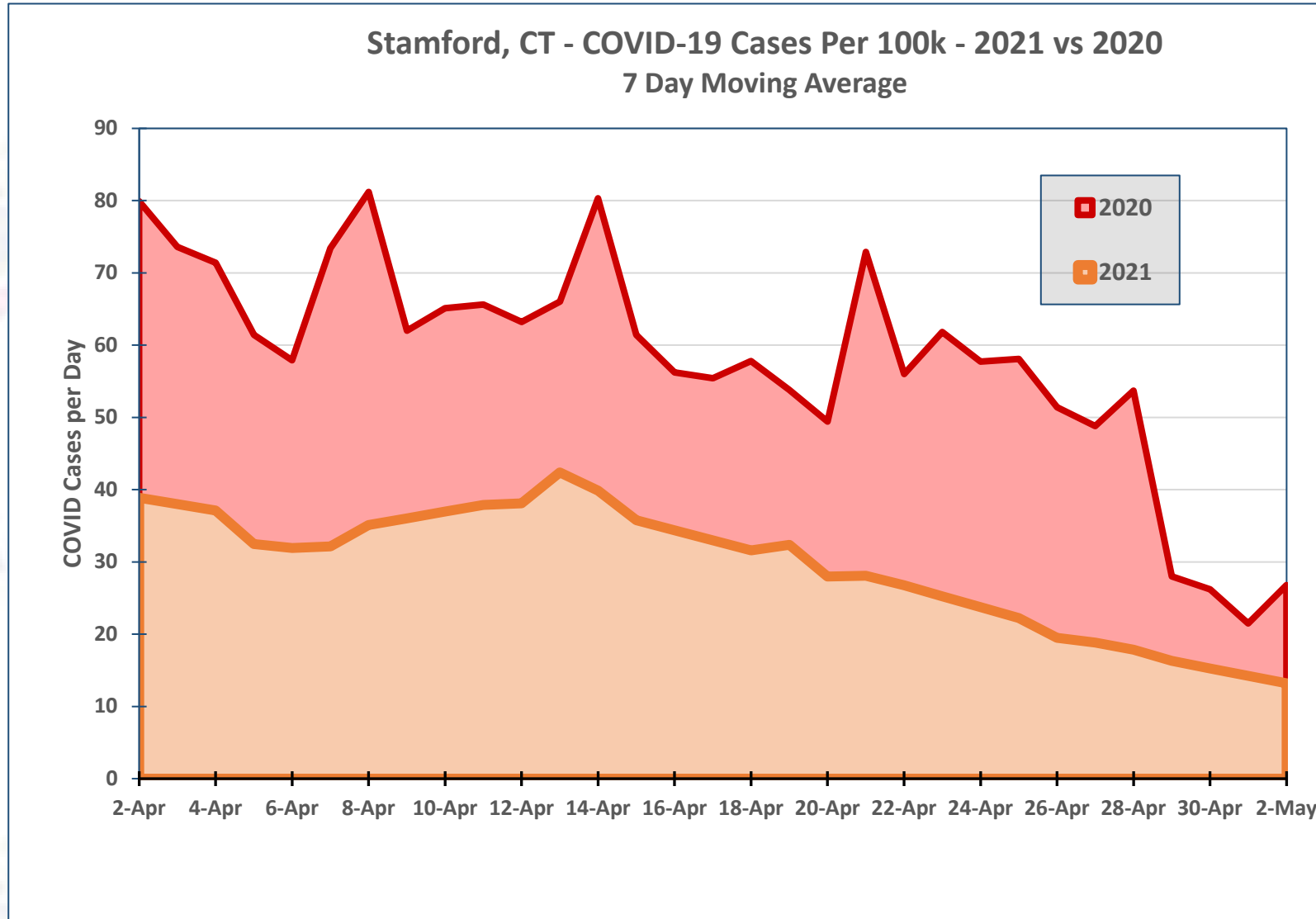

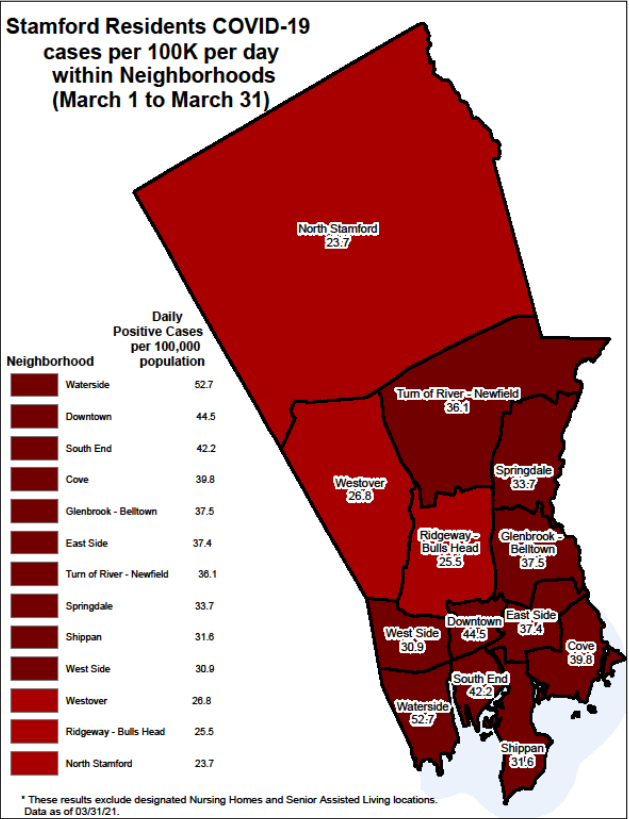
# Stamford COVID cases vs. Year Ago



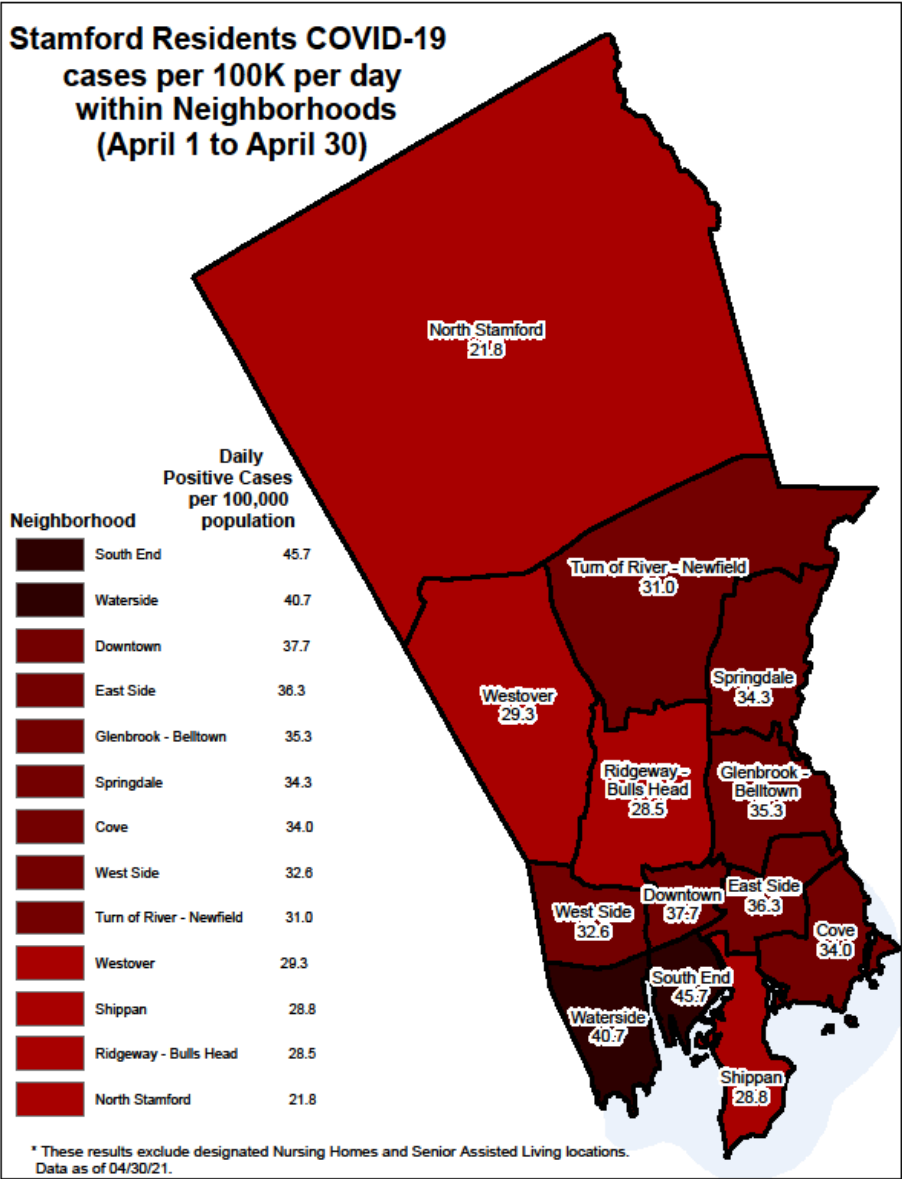

April Neighborhood Map

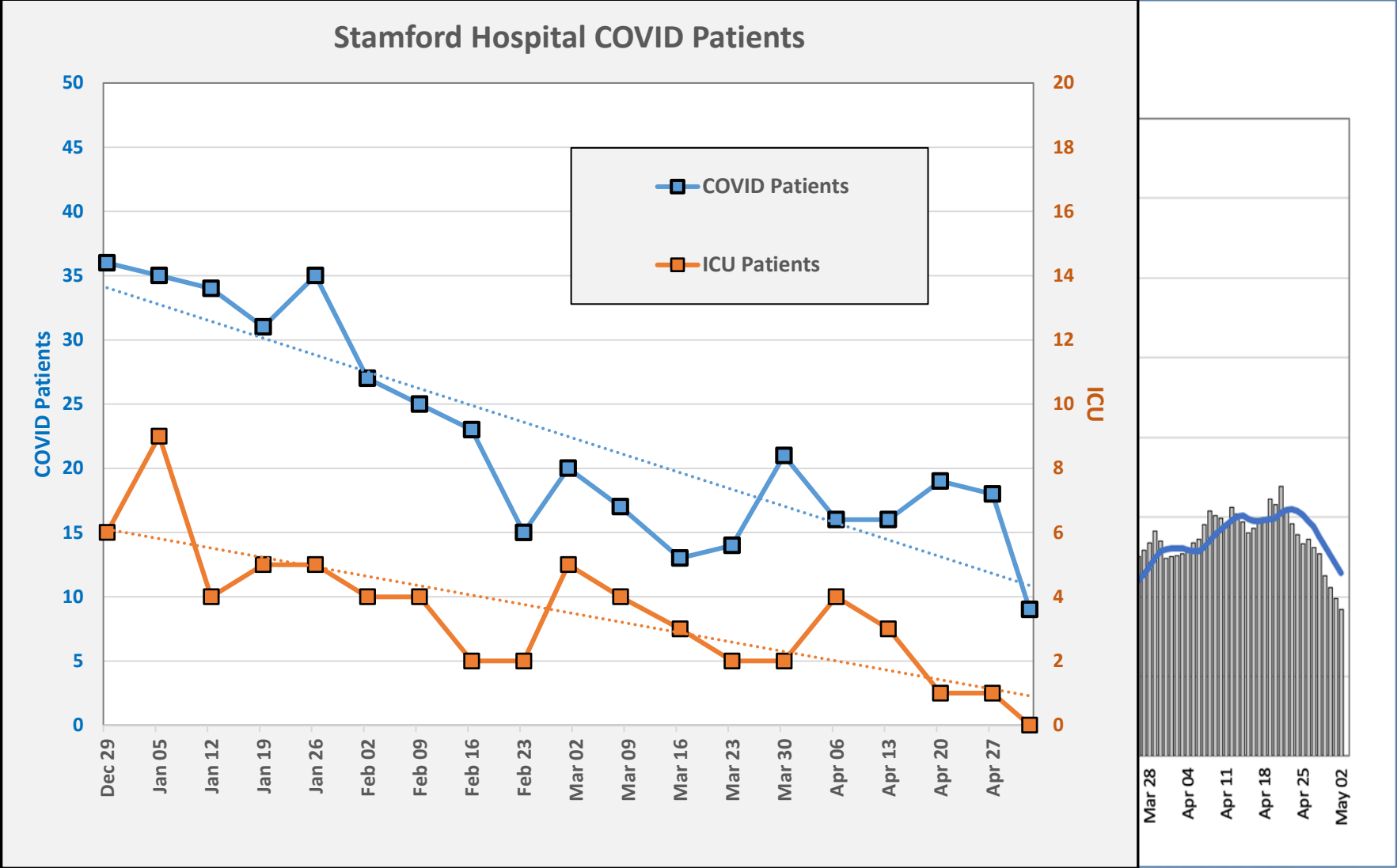

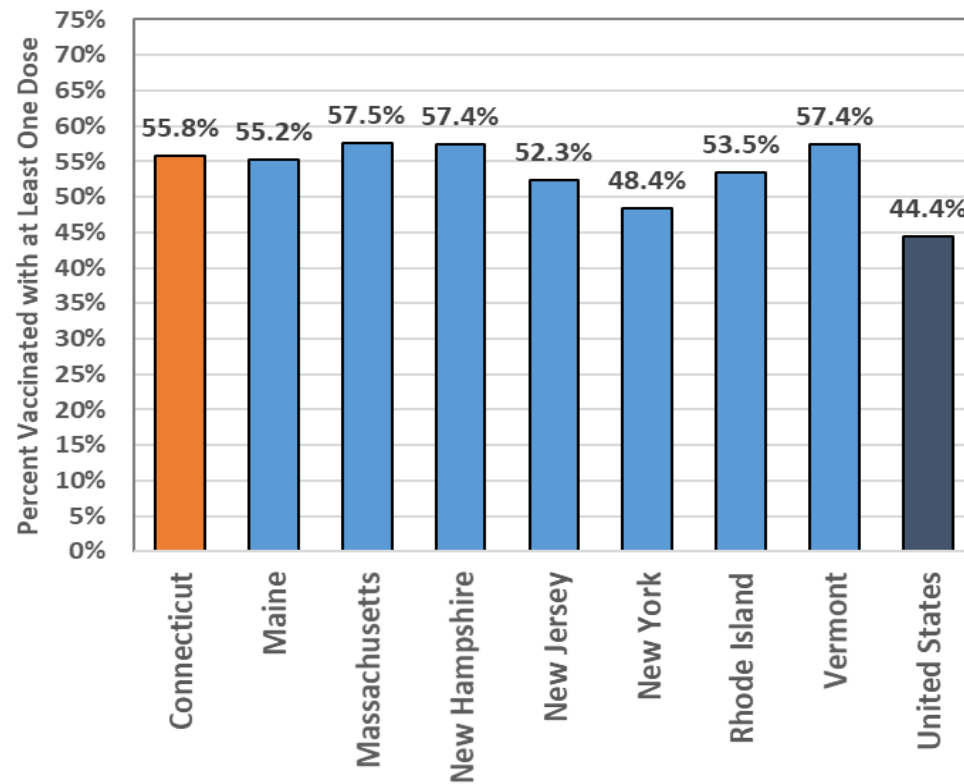
## Hospitalization Rate



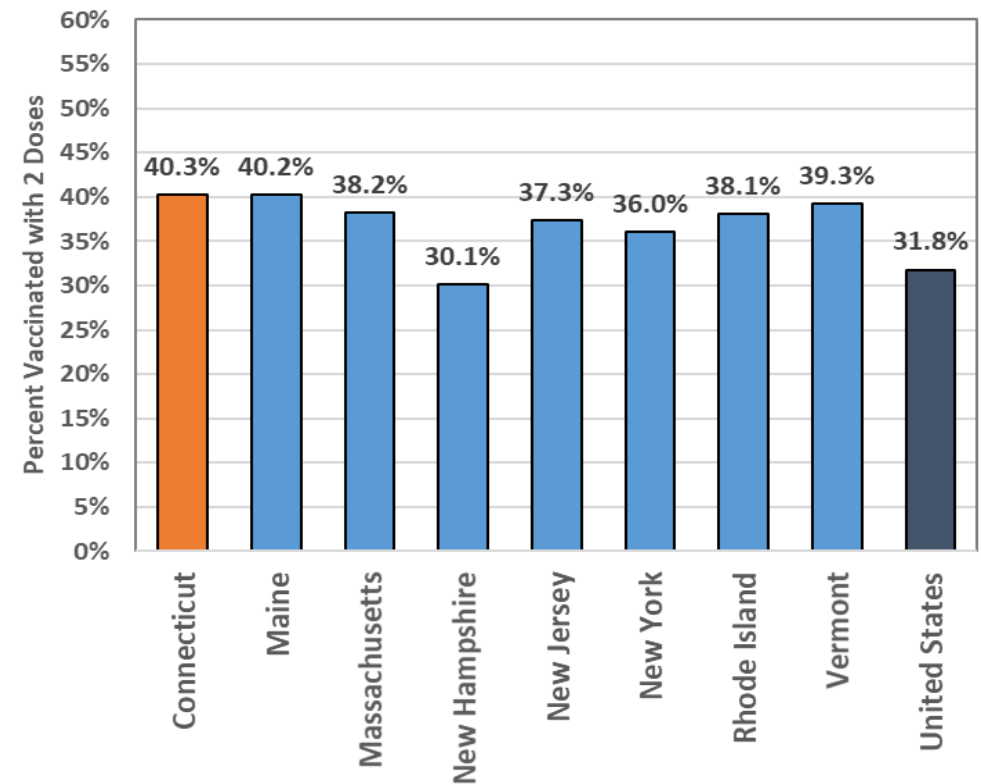
# State of Connecticut: Covid 19 Vaccination Rate

Northeast States

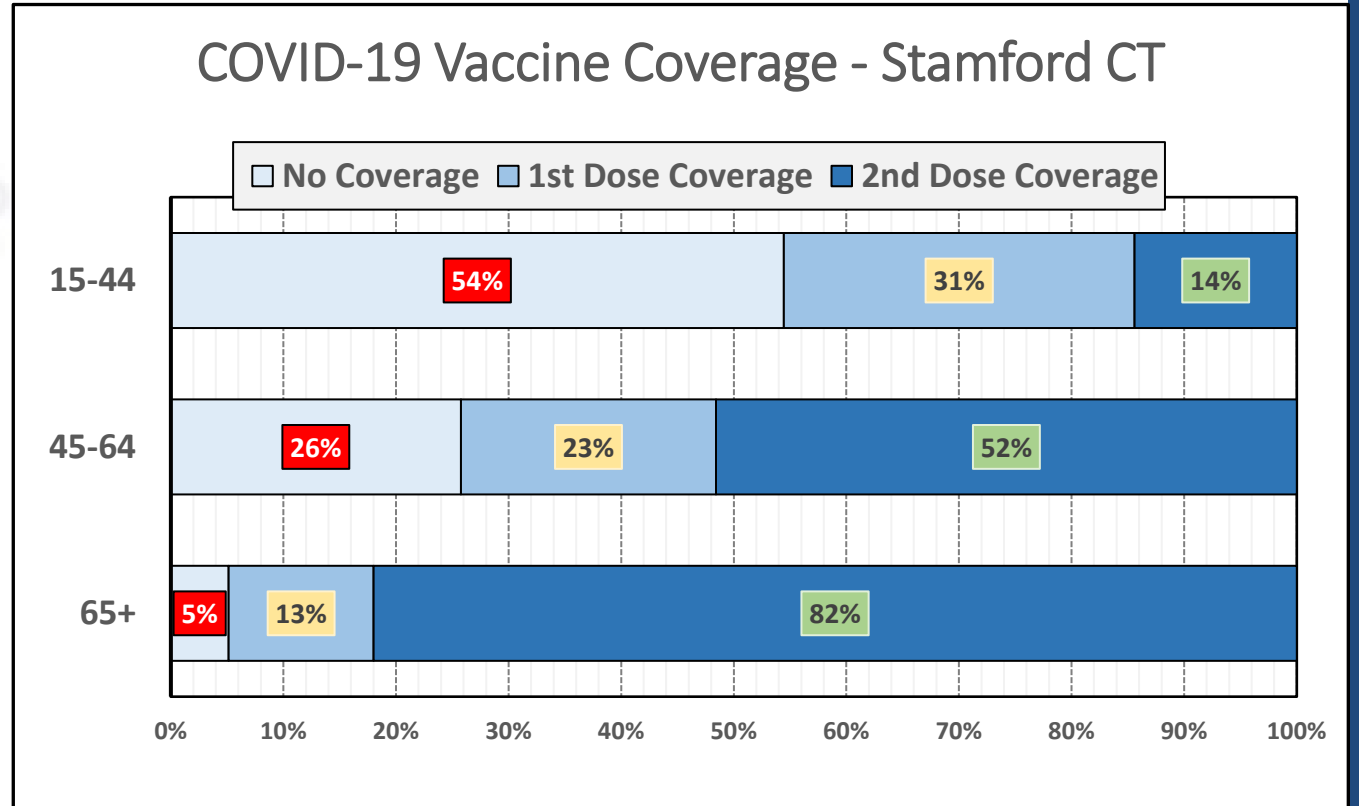
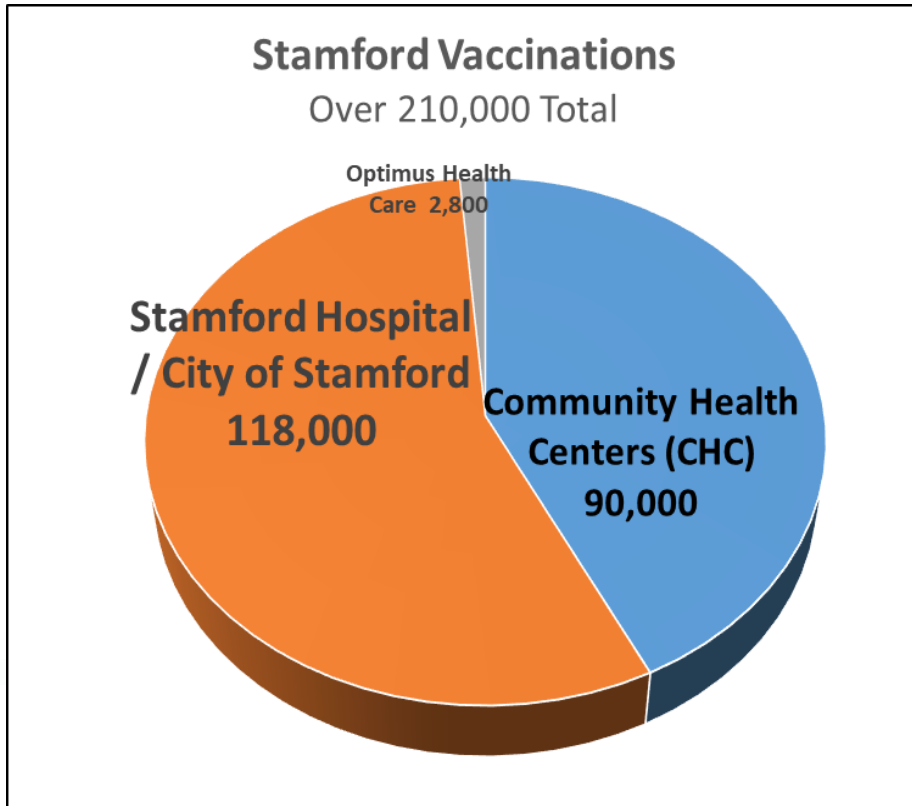


Percent of Pop Fully Vaccinated

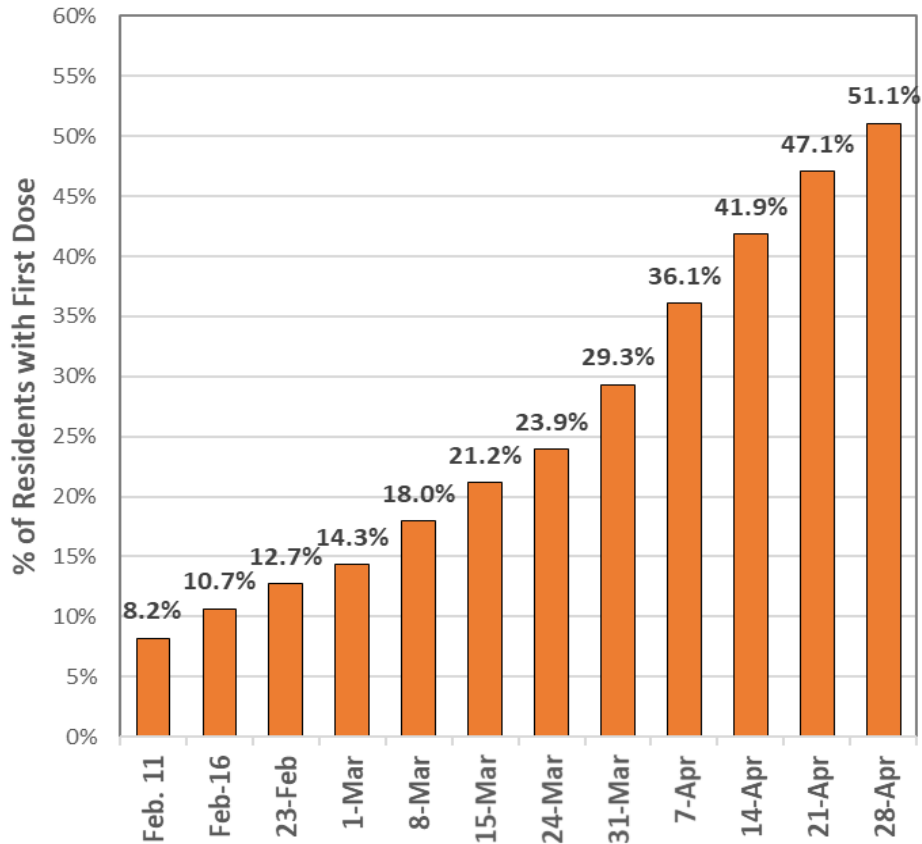

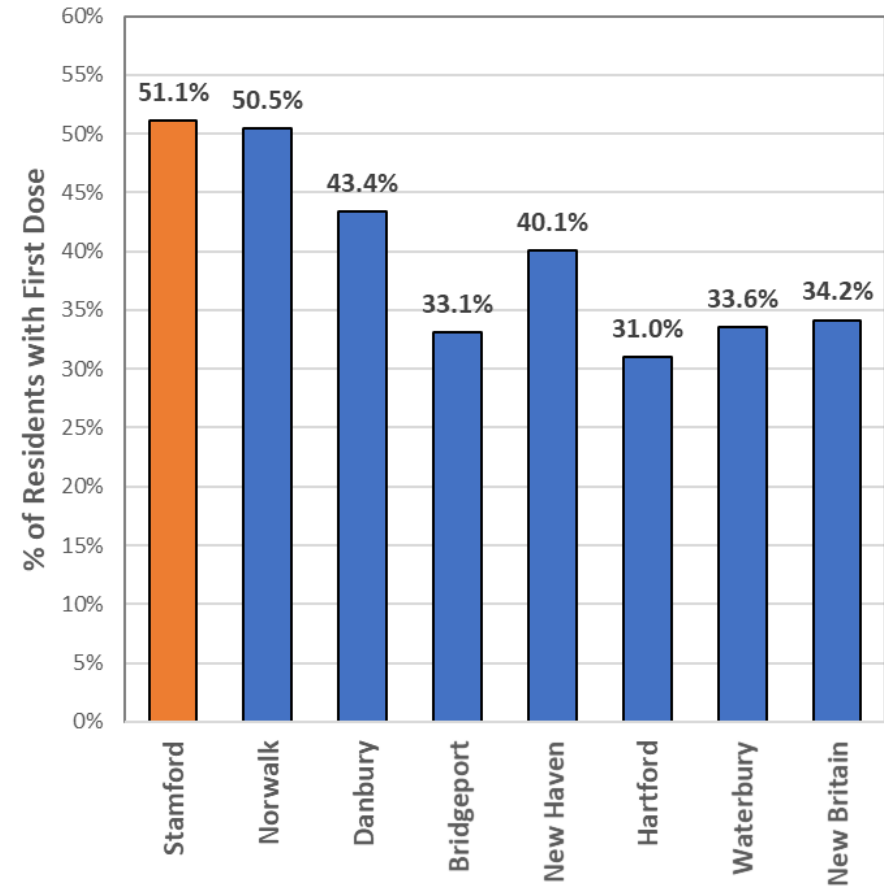
