Approval of Previous Minutes – August 7th, 2014 (00:26)

<u>Motion</u> – Committee member Paul Waldron moves to pass minutes, seconded by Ron Thomas. Minutes pass unanimously. (01:18)

Review of Current Application (01:30)

Ted distributes copy of proposal from camera vendor. One option is a license plate reader, which would require further approval from the Committee as well as notification to the Board of Representatives, who would have 75 days to deny request. Mike Toma reviews Section 18 of the Policies and Procedures Manual with the Committee.

Ted suggests proceeding with Option A, which does not have the automatic recognition feature.

<u>Motion</u> – Chief Fontneau proposes to pursue Option A (purchase a camera without license plate reader). Motion passes unanimously. (12:10)

<u>Motion</u> – to move into Executive Session to discuss confidential aspects of the previously approved application, inviting Mike Toma and Chief Fontneau to join the Committee. Moved by Ted Jankowski, seconded by Paul Waldron, Motion passes. (12:40)
