







State of the City: COVID19 Cases by Neighborhood










State of the City: COVID19 Hospitalization Rate







"In the last several weeks, the majority of people we've seen in the hospital are either not vaccinated or not fully vaccinated," Valassis said.

Doctors at hospitals across the state say they are seeing a similar trend, including Dr. Ohm Deshpande, an internist and vice president of population health for the Yale New Haven Health system. Of the 37 patients hospitalized throughout the Yale New Haven system as of Thursday, he said none were fully vaccinated.

State of Connecticut: Covid 19 Vaccination Rate







