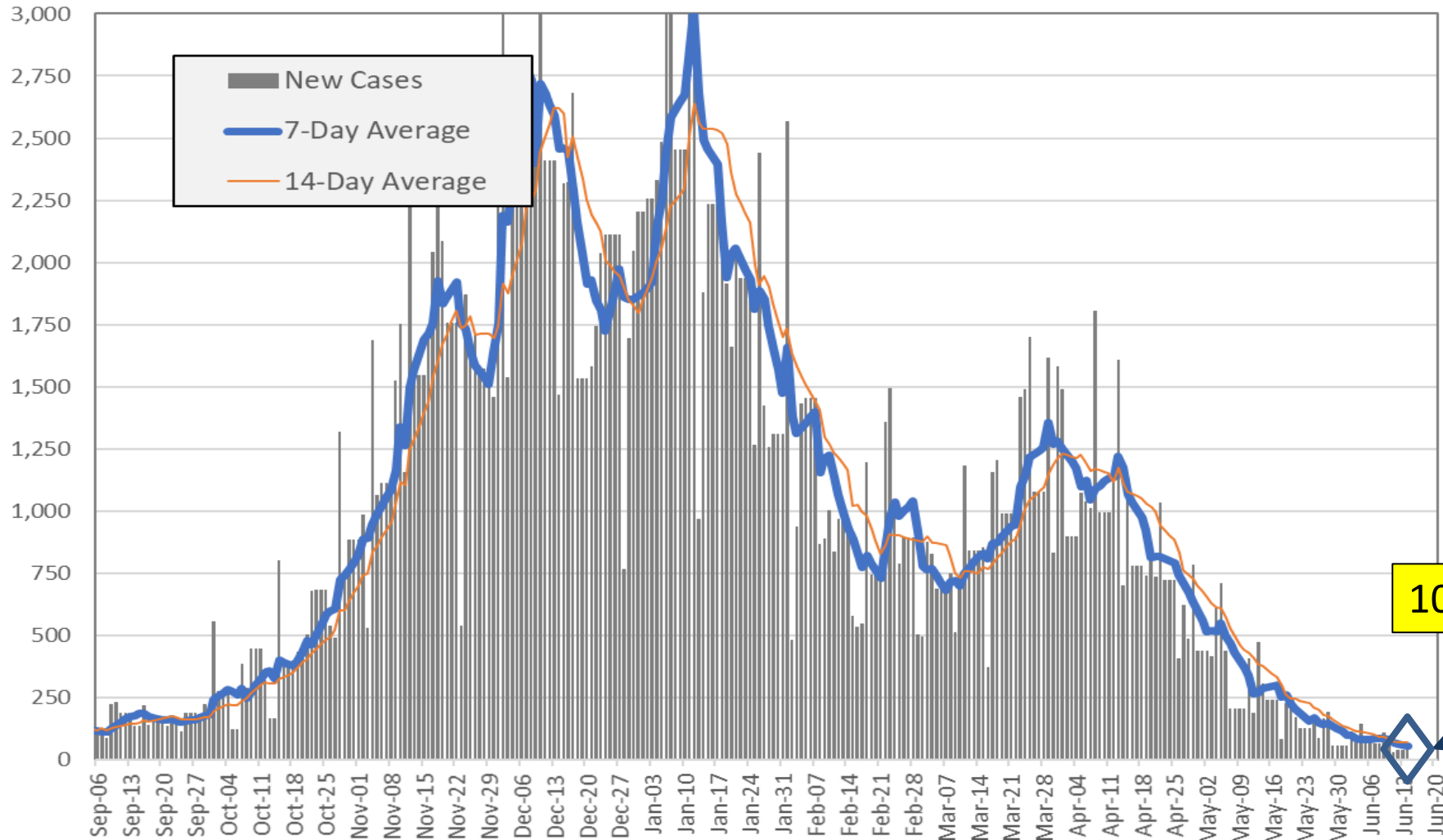
Stamford is Emerging

- ✓ Almost 80% of Stamford adults have been vaccinated
- ✓ Stamford Cases down to 2 new COVID cases per day
- ✓ Lowest 14-day new case moving average since the pandemic began here over 15 months ago
- ✓ No COVID patients in Stamford Hospital ICU for over a month
- ✓ No fatalities in Stamford the last two weeks
- State is closing CHC mass vaccination site at Bull's Head by end of June

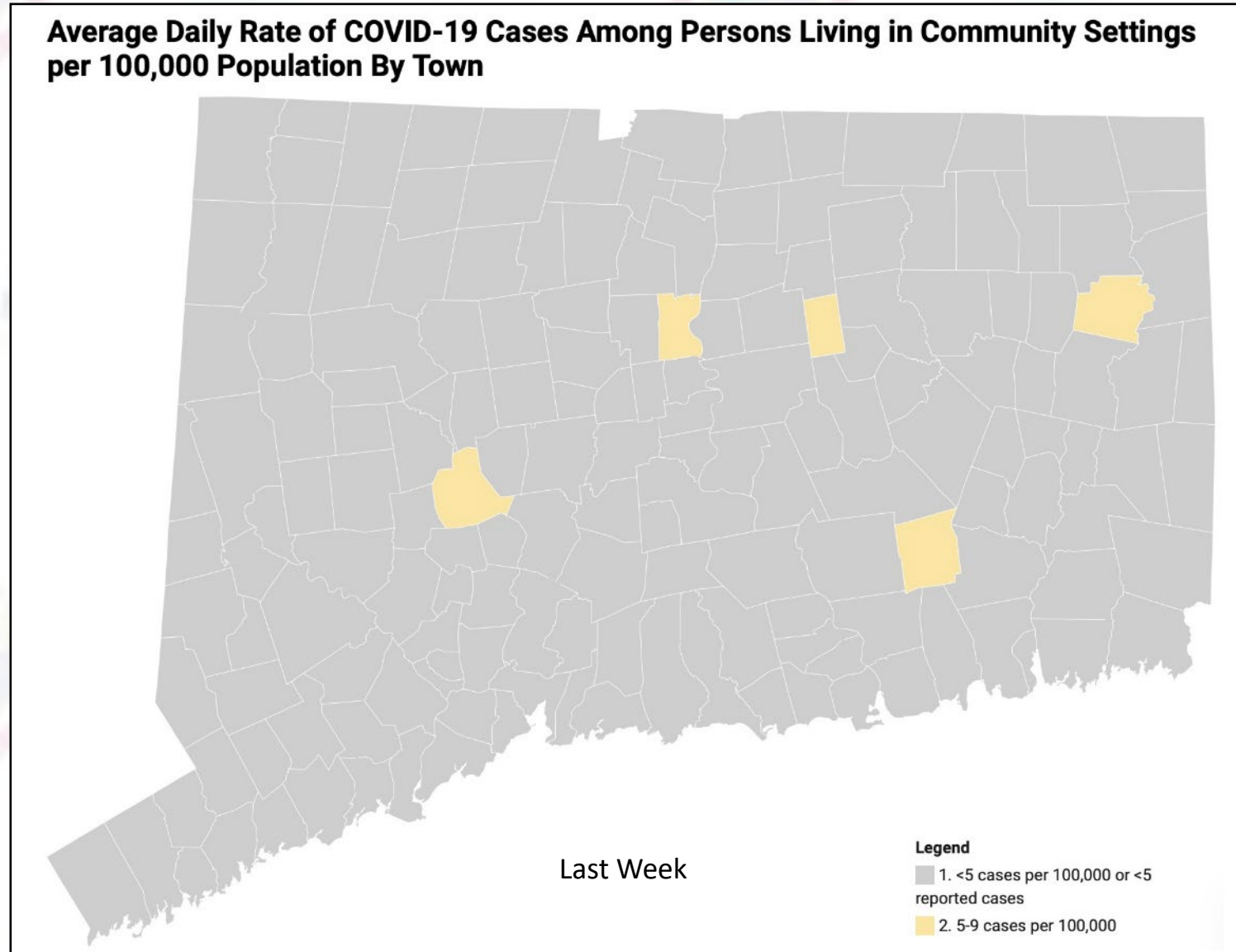

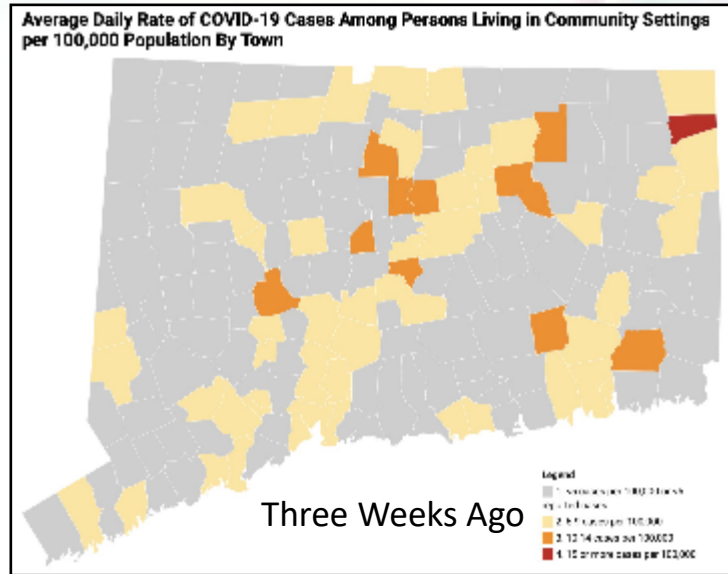

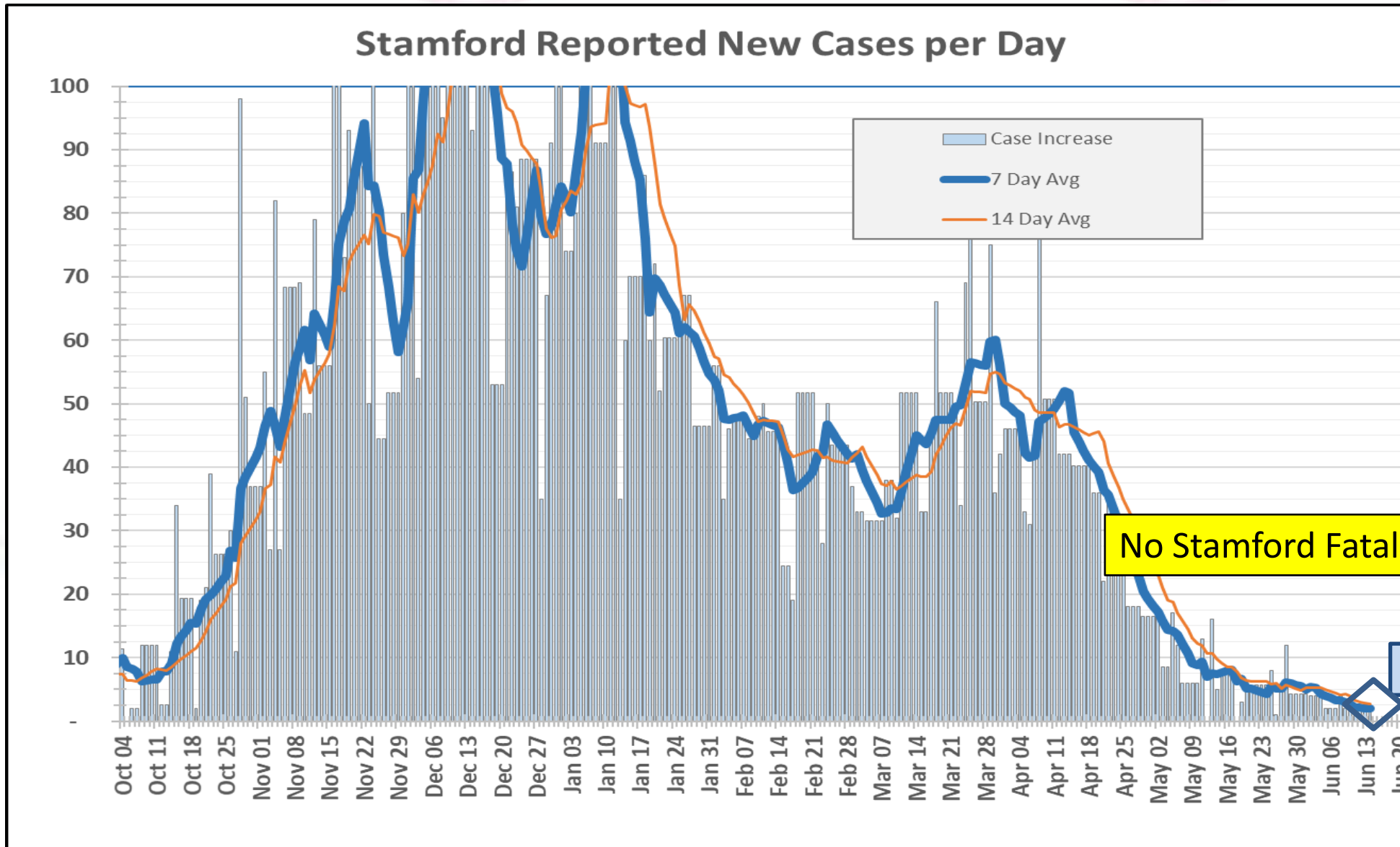

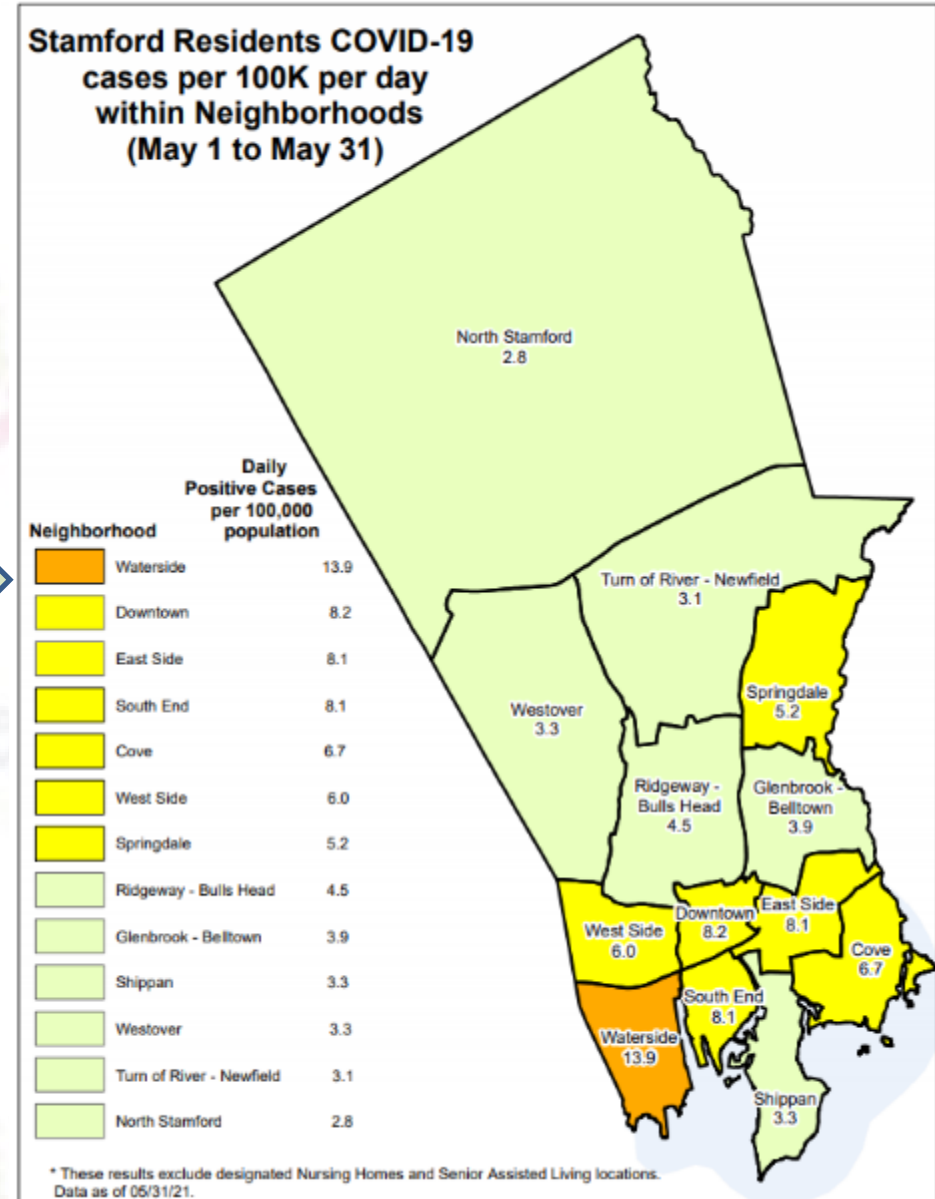
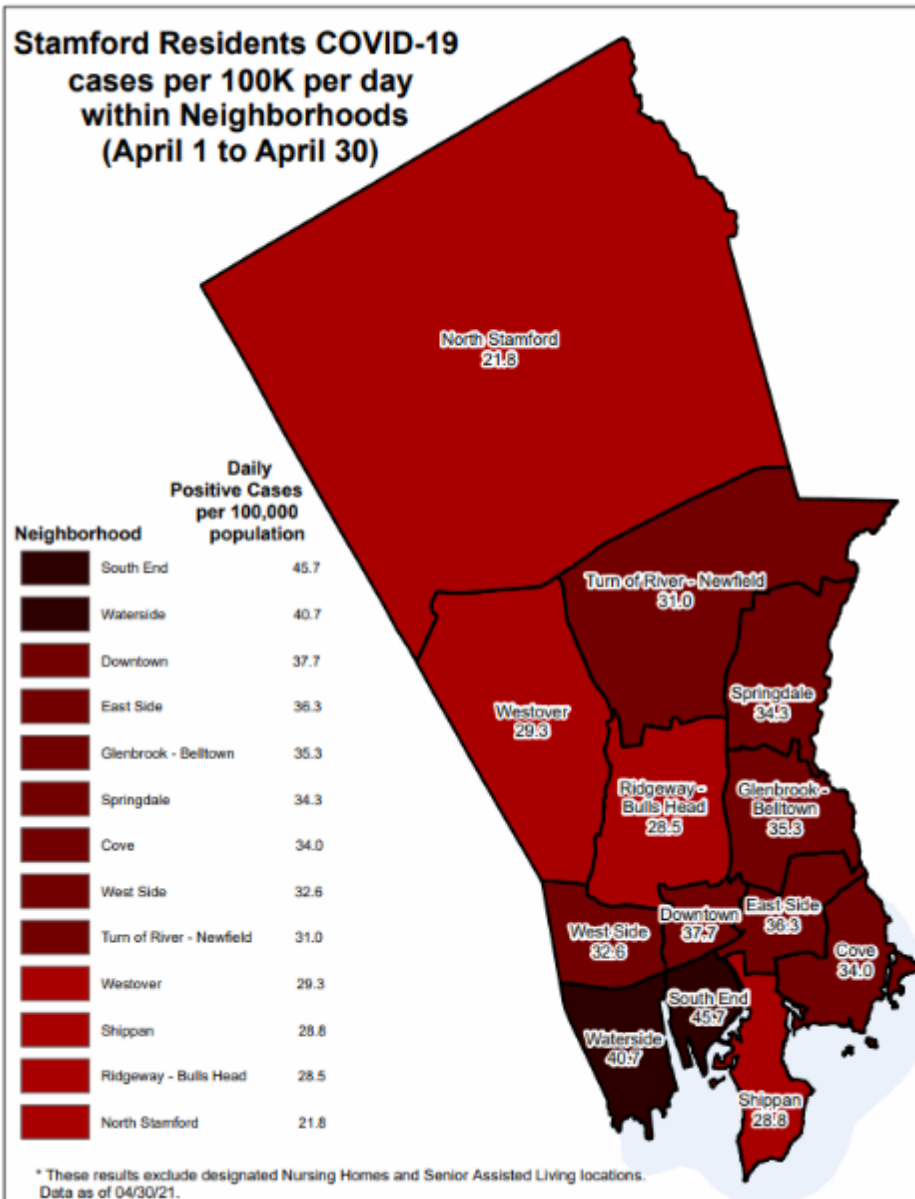

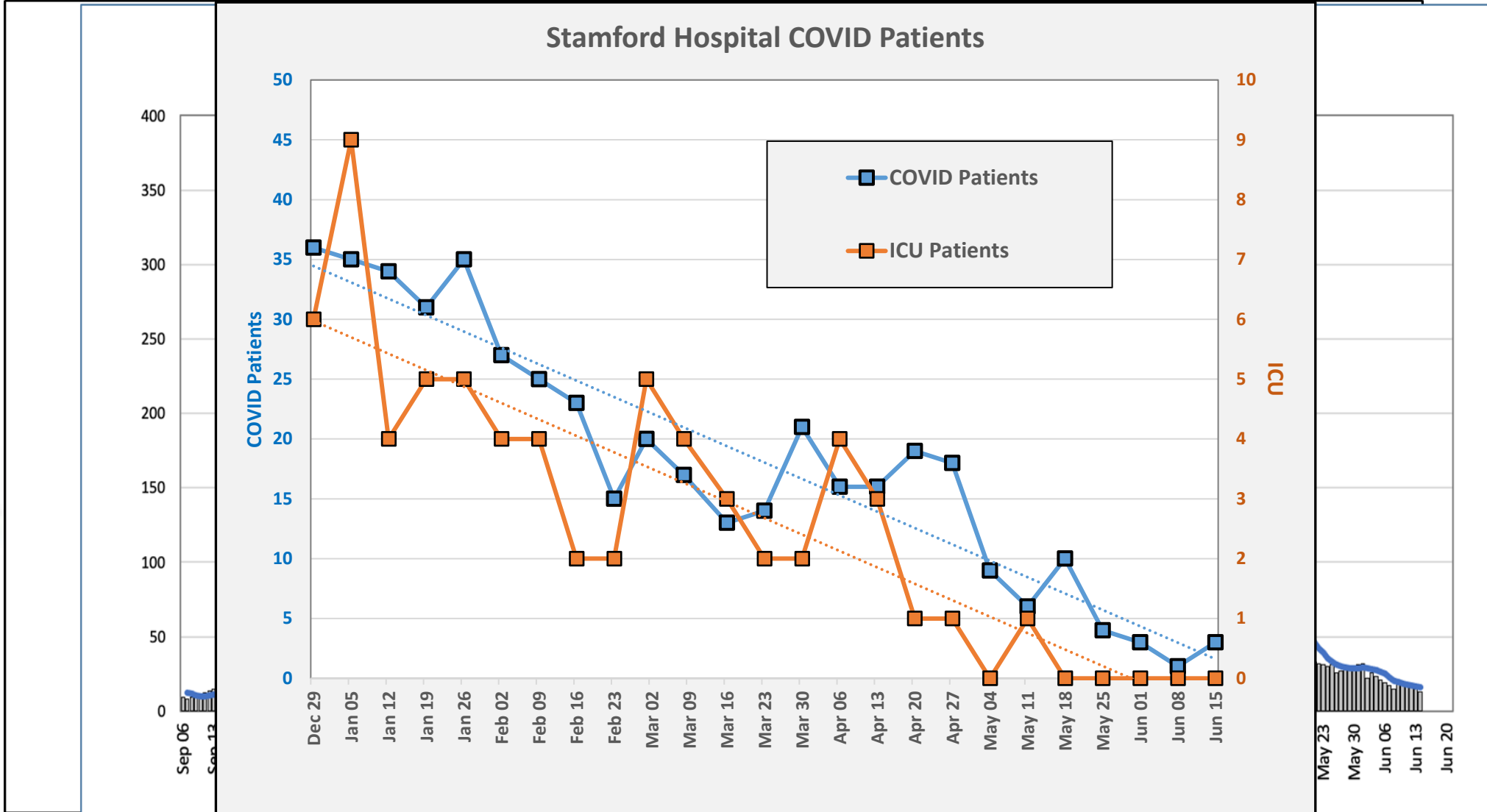

“In the last several weeks, the majority of people we’ve seen in the hospital are either not vaccinated or not fully vaccinated,” Valassis said.

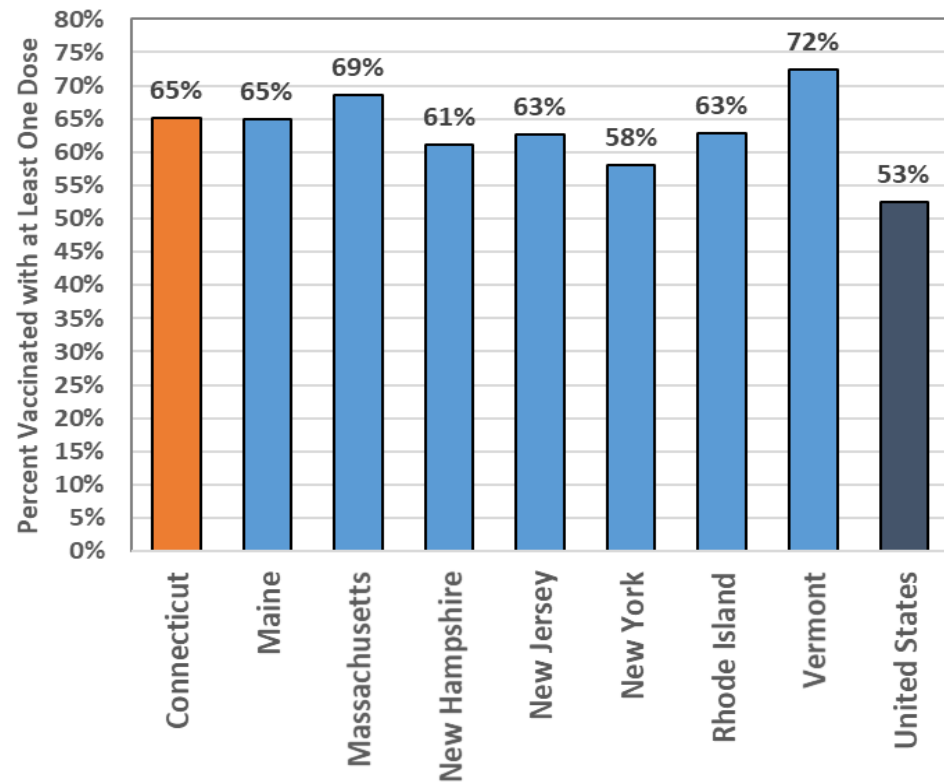
Doctors at hospitals across the state say they are seeing a similar trend, including Dr. Ohm Deshpande, an internist and vice president of population health for the Yale New Haven Health system. Of the 37 patients hospitalized throughout the Yale New Haven system as of Thursday, he said none were fully vaccinated.



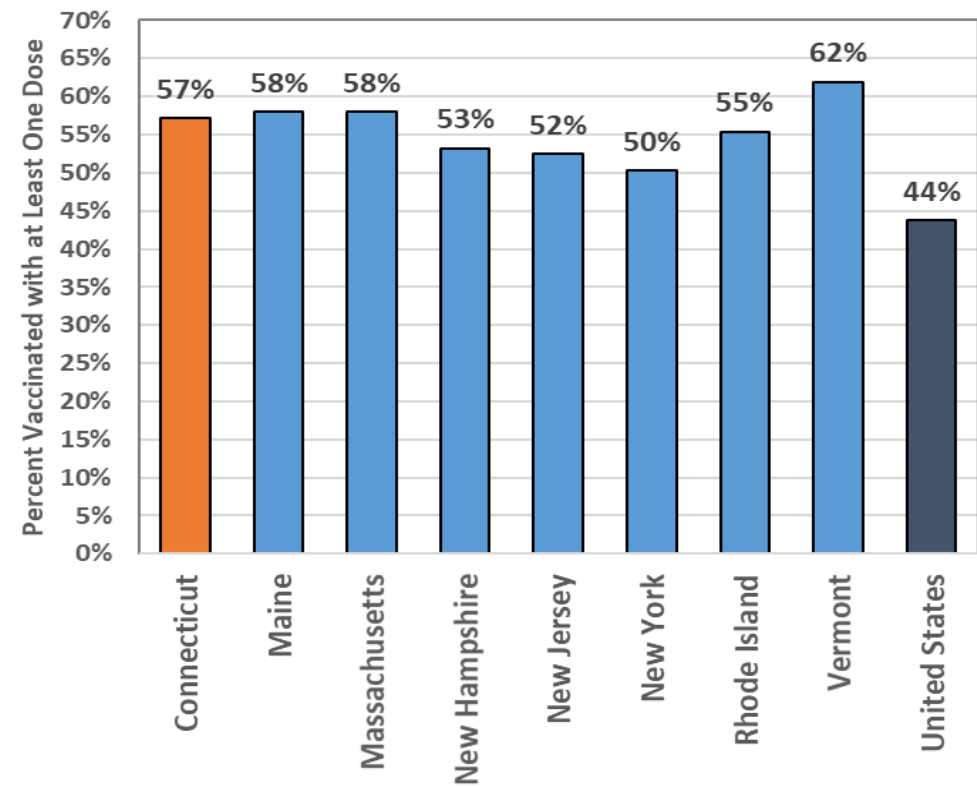
State of Connecticut: Covid 19 Vaccination Rate



Percent of Pop Vaccinated At Least One Dose Northeast States

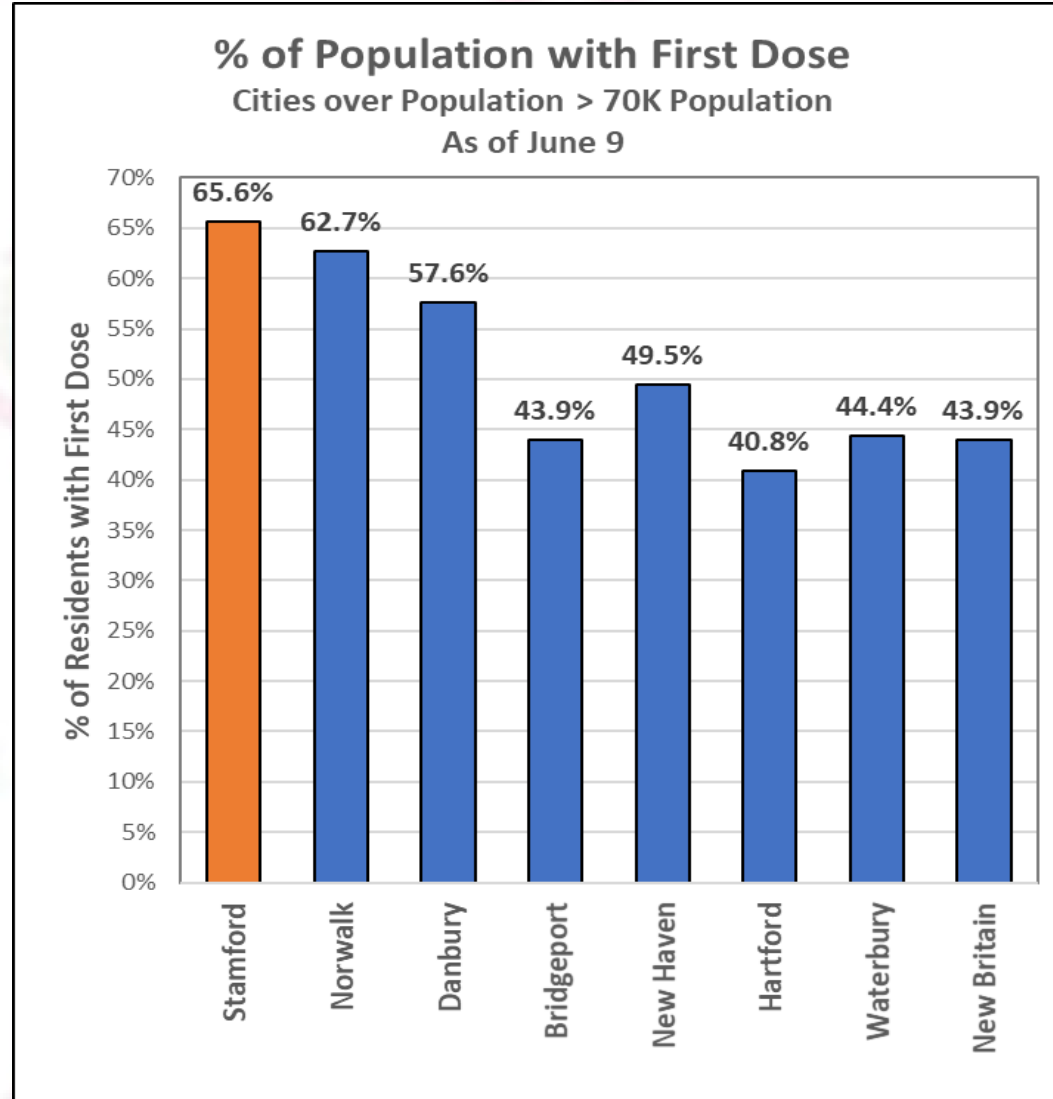
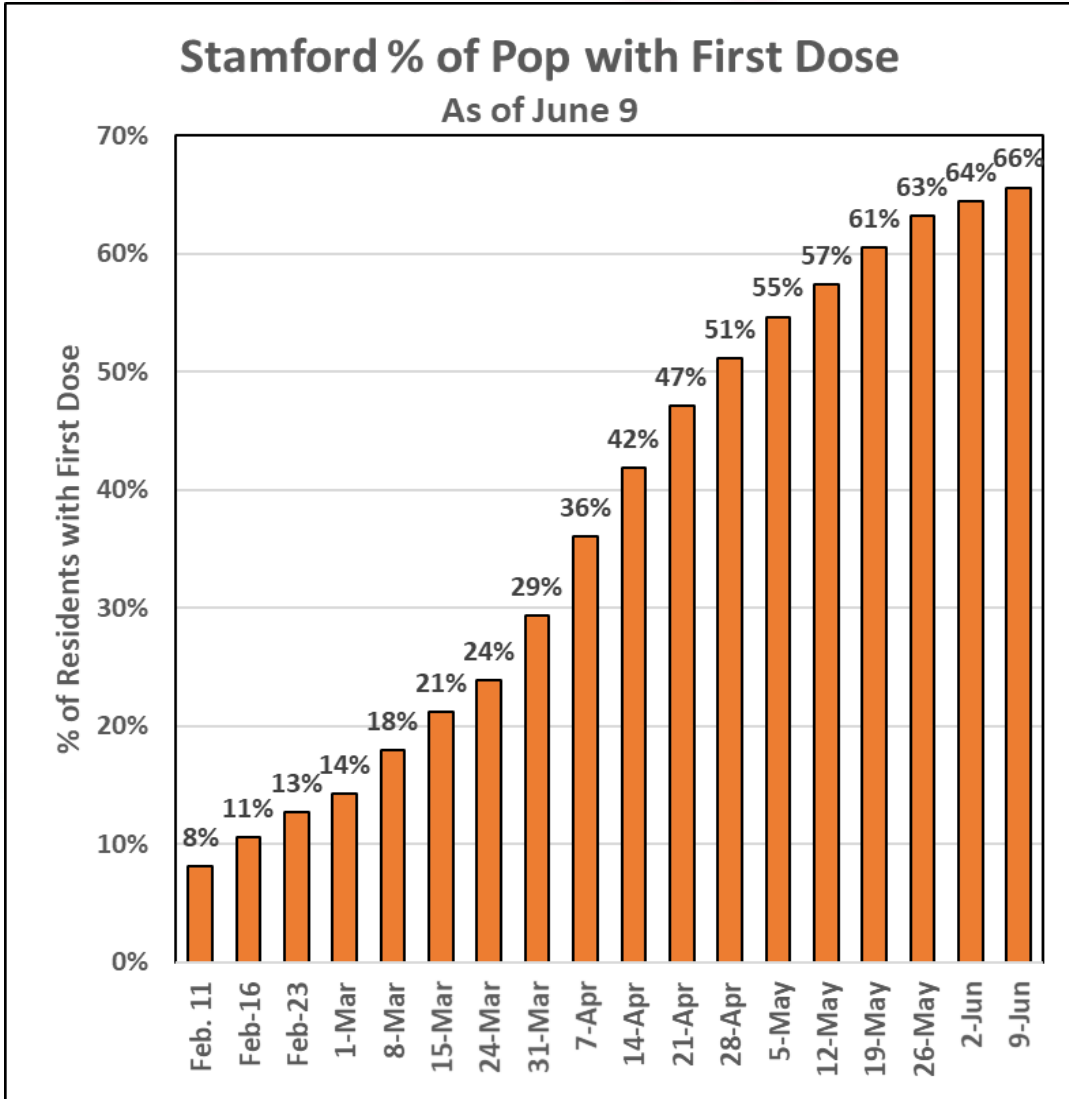


Percent of Pop Fully Vaccinated Northeast States

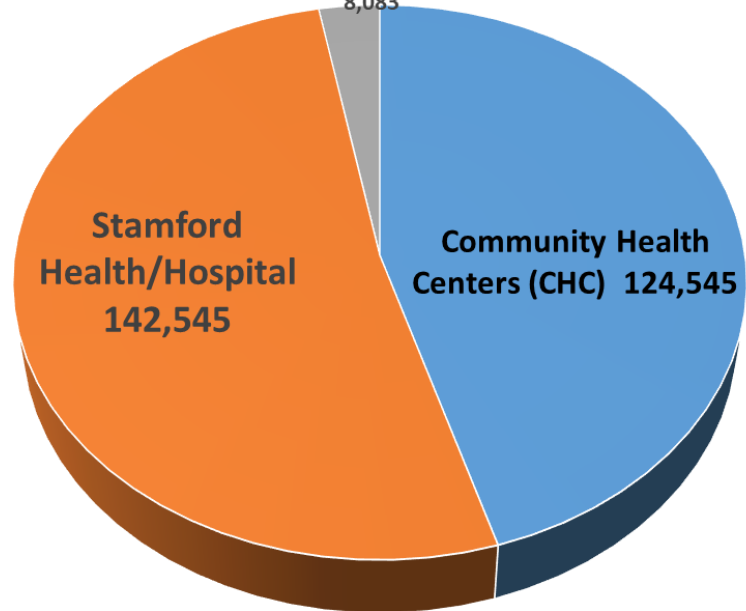

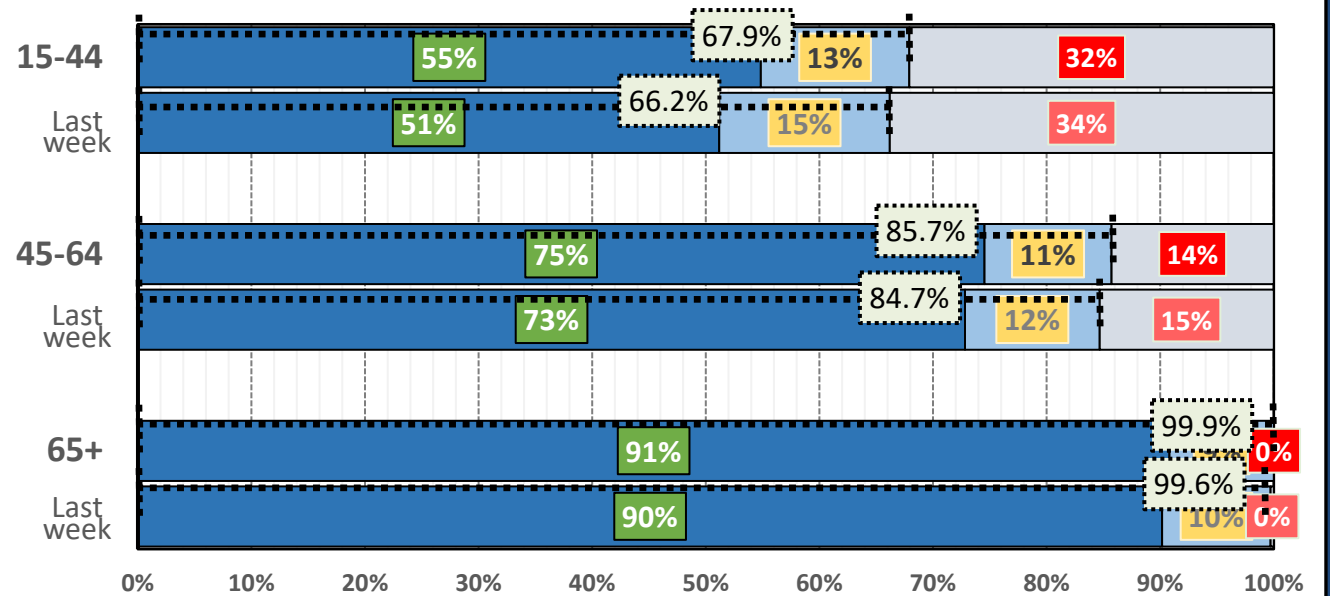

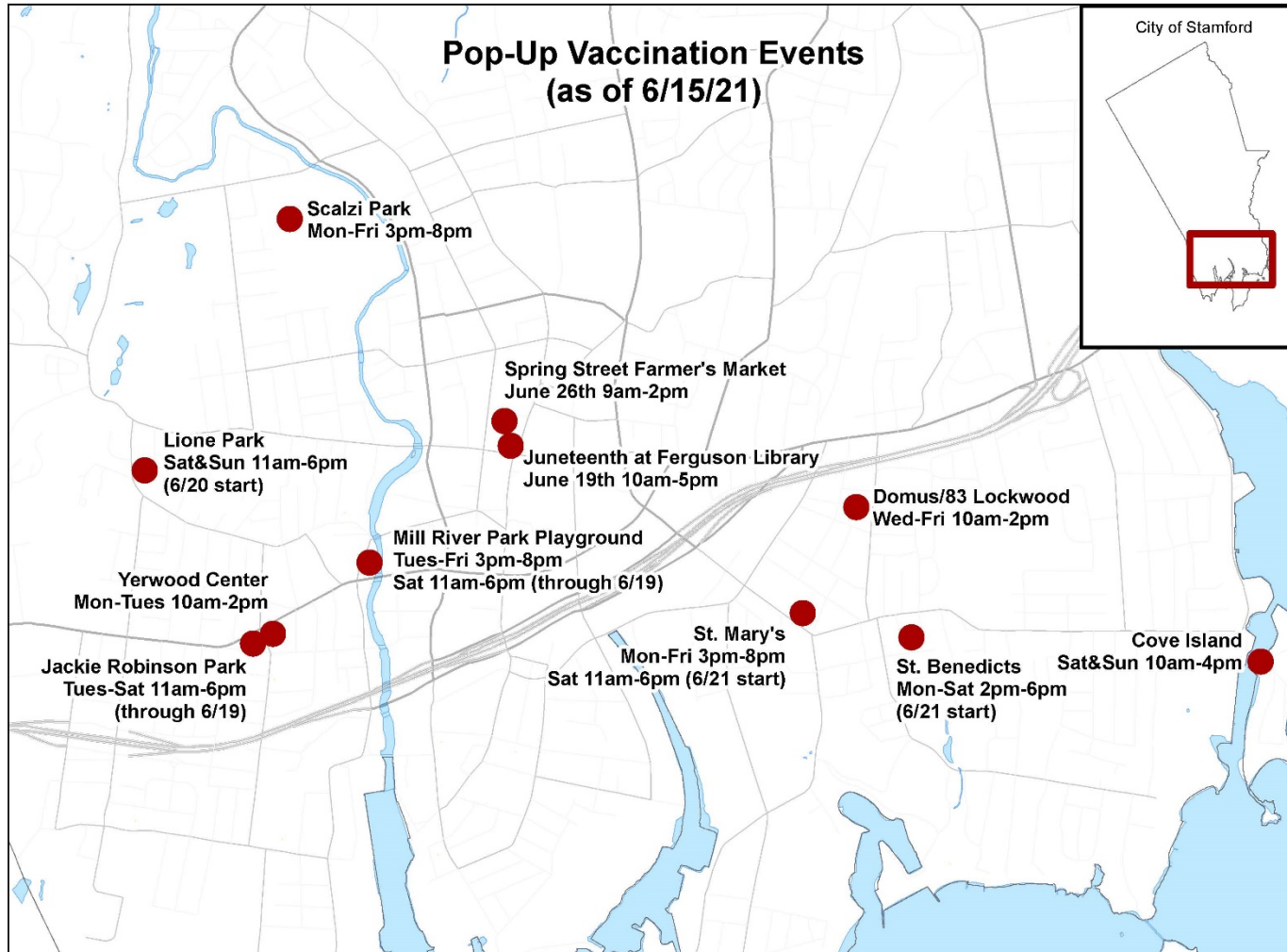
