

2019 Milestones February 2019 - September 2019

February 2019 - June 2019 Atlantic Street Underpass Closed



1. A new center pier will be installed; south assembly area constructed; Atlantic St. widened

June 28 – July 8, 2019
Atlantic St./South State St.
Detours



2. The old bridge will be demolished and the new bridge will be rolled into place on Atlantic Street. All tracks restored.

July 9 – September 7,2019 Atlantic St./South State St. Detours



3. Atlantic Street will be lowered to accommodate the new bridge clearance of 14' 6".

September 8, 2019 All Roads Re-open




4. Atlantic Street and South State Street will re-open with road work & bridge work completed.



Phase 2 Project Current Status Multiple Concurrent Operations Underway

BRIDGE SUBSTRUCTURE

At Atlantic Street, construction under existing bridge for the bridge substructure components includes drilling more than 200 micropiles and constructing new foundations.









Phase 2 Project Current Status Multiple Concurrent Operations Underway

RETAINING WALL

Along South State Street, new retaining wall under construction for new Track #7 includes drilled shafts and installation of H Piles. Precast lagging forms the new wall.








Phase 2 Project Current Status Multiple Concurrent Operations Underway

BRIDGE SUPERSTRUCTURE

Bridge superstructure foundations under construction. Six bridge decks will be assembled at two locations for transport to the site.

Between South State Street and Dock Street


On/About February 19, 2019 - September 8, 2019

- 1. Reduce duration of the road closure
- 2. Installation of center pier under the bridge
- 3. Prepare for Bridge Roll-in
- 1. NO Rail Service Disruptions
- 2. Pedestrian Access OPEN (until June 28, 2019)
- 3. Shuttle, Taxi, CT Transit and Drop-Off areas OPEN
- 4. Parking garage access maintained
- 5. Planned detours for motorists




Construction Operations: Feb 19 - June 28, 2019

- A new Center Pier will support the wider and longer span
- Atlantic Street will be widened to include 3 lanes in each direction and increase vertical clearance of 14'6".





2019 Milestones June 2019

What is happening?

South State Street Closed: Guernsey Ave to the I-95 NB Off-Ramp Atlantic Street Closed: North State Street to Dock Street

When is it happening?

On/About June 28, 2019 - September 8, 2019

Why do Atlantic Street & South State Street need to close?


- 1. Roll-in new bridge
- 2. Lower and widen Atlantic Street
- 3. Complete new roadway

What are the impacts?

- 1. Two Track Rail Service, (June 28-July 8)
- 2. Pedestrian detour through Train Station
- 3. **DETOUR** for motorists
- 4. South State access to North side commuter DROP OFF/PICK UP ONLY.
- 5. Guernsey Avenue ONE WAY to N. State St. ONLY


Pedestrian Detour June - September 2019

Sidewalk Closures:

 Atlantic Street (btw N. and S. State St & Dock St)

Detours:

- Guernsey Avenue
- Via Train Station
 Tunnel/Overpass
- Station Place
- Access to S. State Street until Stage 2 (June 2019)





Bridge Roll-in: June 28-July 8, 2019

New bridge superstructure is transported into place from the North Assembly area via S. State Street for the north side of the bridge.



The bridge decks for the south side of the bridge are rolled into place right from the job site.





Lower Atlantic Street: July 8-September 8, 2019

Atlantic Street will be lowered providing clearance of 14'6"



Roadway, illumination, signage and, brick pavers completed.
All roads re-opened by Sept. 8, 2019





Bridge Roll In and Lowering of Atlantic Street Construction Detours June 28th – September 9th, 2019


Road Closures:

- Atlantic Street
 (Dock St to N. State St)

Detours:

- Guernsey Avenue
 (NB to N. State Street ONLY)
- Washington Henry Canal St.
- Dock Street / North State Street
- Station Place

North Side Station Drop Off Open
Enter via Washington Blvd; Exit Via Guernsey Ave. to N. State Street


