- Discussed the quantity and types of applications submitted to the Land Use Bureau and their potential impact on the efforts of the study committee's efforts

### Status of Grant

- It was determined that the Study Committee should request from the Land Use Bureau a consolidated list of property owners to be contacted pursuant to the requirements of the state and the grant. (The list of property owners from the assessor's office is different than the tax collectors list).
