She will also be promoting monthly health topics. • There were two resignations in School Nursing. • Community nursing is well staffed. Promotion of Clinic services needs to be emphasized. • Ms. Patricia Parry asked if we bill for services at the clinic. • The Laboratory continues to perform the regular services, such as tick identification, rabies, and water testing. The Director of Laboratory also has been providing continued support to the COVID-19 Program. • Ms. Lorraine Olson asked about the hiring of a Dental Case Manager and other positions. • Ms. Lorraine Olson asked about COVID in schools.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ms. Brittany Dube describe her job functions, including some work towards HD accreditation and COVID grant management. • Positions will be refilled. • Ms. Judith Bennett, Director of Nursing and Dental Services, and Ms. Brittany Dube will be working together to get the information out. • At this time we do not. • Ms. Patricia Parry clarified tick testing is not done in Stamford but is sent to the agricultural station. • Staffing gaps are in the process of being filled. • COVID testing will be performed weekly on unvaccinated children in schools. Positive cases of COVID should be reported to the Board of Education (BOE) and BOE will work with the School Nurse Supervisor.
