- **BBS** Viking met with BBS to discuss A/E projects on 3/7. They discussed the following issues:
 - Grading
 - o Caulk joints at the precast- most likely a summer project
 - o Roof area over concrete at front entrance.
- Mold Task Force Met with parents and faculty on 3/20 to discuss upcoming work at Davenport.
- <u>Trees</u>- City cleared trees on school property to reduce amount of leaves and debris that get caught in catch basin and gutters.
- <u>Catch Basins-</u> Vacuumed 6 clogged catch basins, 4 silt sacks and jetted storm pipes. Bell traps will be ordered and installed in catch basins.
- <u>Roof</u>- Viking has uncovered 6 active leaks in the envelope. Gottfried has conducted a roof assessment and a report was published on the <u>website</u>. Suggested repairs and maintenance costs for roof estimated to costs \$121,540. These repairs will help avoid further leaks. Infrared scan of the roof scheduled to be performed
- Rooms 28-29- Complete gut of rooms 28 and 29 scheduled to begin on March 29th. Scope of work published on website.
- <u>Drainage-</u> BBS evaluating grading issues at various levels due to leaks at the floor level. Report expected from Viking Construction.
