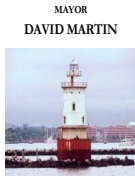

  - a. Mill River Vegetation; Removal and disposal into the Mill River of vegetation by CoS workers was noted. The issue was reported to the appropriate CoS personnel and the practice will not be repeated.
  - b. WPCA Spill; 10/15/21 at 8:15am approximately 500 gallons of raw sewage spilled when a clarifier overflowed from a surge. The overflow went onto the catch basins and ultimately into the East Branch of the Harbor.
  - c. WPCA Spill; Washington blvd. 10/8/21 at 12:50pm approximately 15-20 gallons of raw spilled when a sanitary sewer line was clogged by grease. The overflow went onto the storm sewer and ultimately to the Long Island Sound via the pumping station at Dyke Ln. The incident was reported to the DEEP.
