Draft Minutes -Special Meeting of the Fire Commission held Monday, March 3, 2014

Call to order: Chairman Melzer called the meeting to order at 4:02pm.

Interview of Firefighter Candidates:

At the onset of each interview the Commission asked each candidate if they wished the interview to be open or closed. If the candidate requests a closed interview, the Commission moved to go into executive session, at the end of each interview the Commission moved to come out of Executive session. If the candidate elected an open interview, the interview was held in the open and not in executive session.
